Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending October 31, 1994, amounted to 856,031 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of October was 567,669 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 6,531,630 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 2,919,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 238,200 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(94)-10", dated November 22, 1994.

The next "Cotton Ginnings" report will be released at 3 p.m. ET on December 22, 1994.
