## Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending September 30, 1996, amounted to 1,026,758 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of September was 533,855 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 2,059,562 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 2,556,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters was 268,400 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(96)-09", dated October 24, 1996.
