## Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending September 30, 1997, amounted to 1,101,672 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of September was 610,259 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 1,999,699 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 2,639,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters was 276,300 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(97)-9", dated October 23, 1997.

The next "Cotton Ginnings" report will be released at 8:30 p.m. ET on November 25, 1997.
