Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of October was 535,165 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 6,536,639 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 2,635,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 301,800 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(97)-10", dated November 21, 1997.
