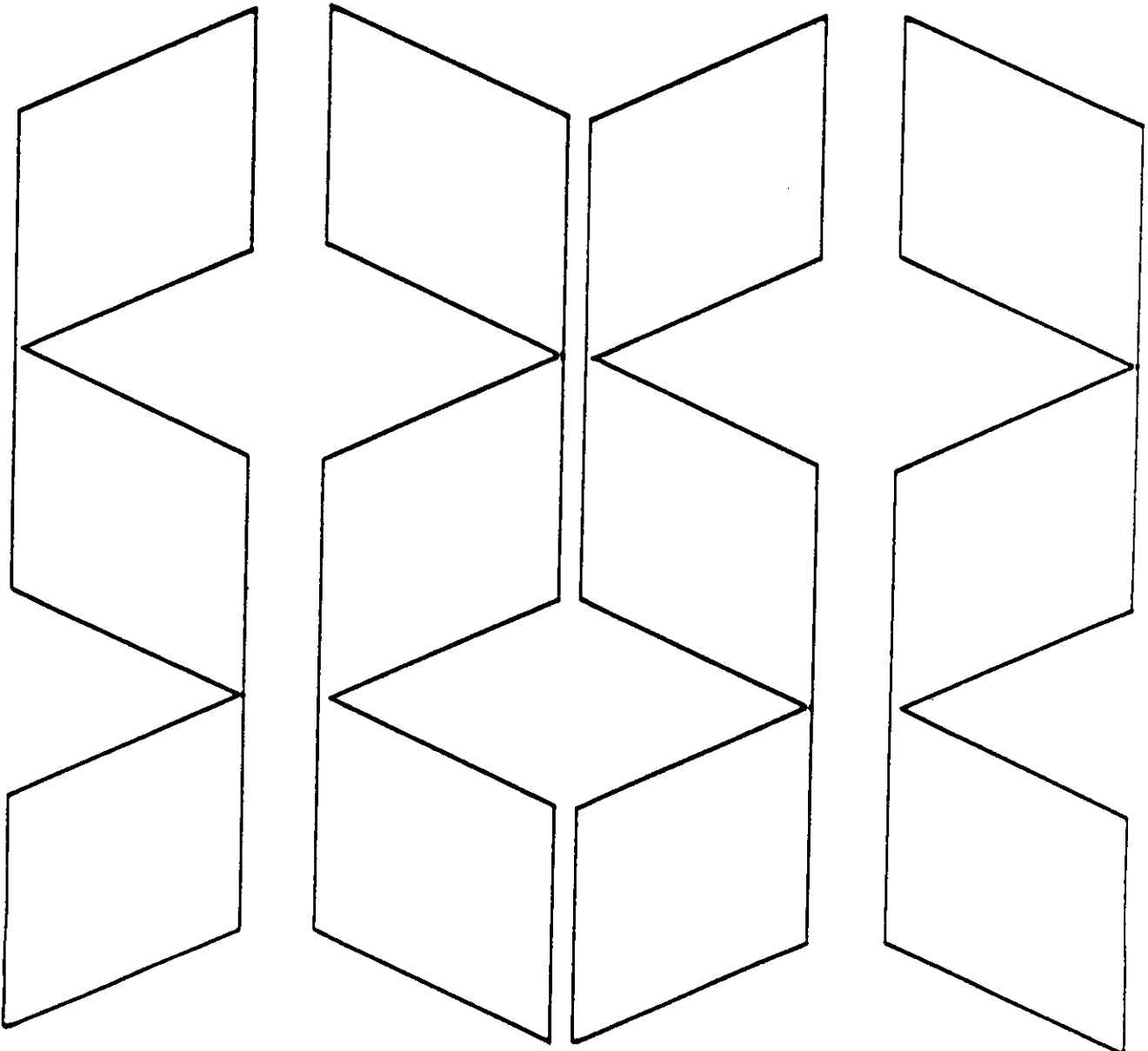

CROP VALUES

MARKETING YEAR AVERAGE PRICES AND VALUE OF PRODUCTION, BY STATES AND UNITED STATES, 1988, 1989, AND 1990

CROP VALUES includes average prices and value of production for major field crops and for many special crops. All prices in this report are marketing year average prices which do not include allowances or adjustments for commodities under government loan at the end of the marketing year, commodities forfeited to the Commodity Credit Corporation, crop deficiency payments or disaster payments. Estimates shown for 1990 crops are preliminary.

Each State price is based on months comprising its marketing year, while United States marketing year averages are based on the standard U.S. marketing year for each crop. See page 3 of this report for a listing of marketing years by crop for the United States.

Preliminary marketing year average price estimates for 1990 are based on entire month prices through November for wheat, oats, barley, corn, sorghum, soybeans, flaxseed, peanuts, rice, potatoes, dry edible beans, and sunflower with an allowance for projected prices for the remainder of the marketing year. Upland cotton prices are based on data through mid-December 1990. Tobacco prices are estimates for the entire season, except those types for 1990 which have insufficient sales and were valued the same as the previous year or estimated based on price changes of other similar types. Fruit and vegetable prices are based on entire month prices for the season ending in the calendar year specified in the heading of the table. Prices for other commodities, for which monthly data are available, are based on mid-month prices through November with allowance for projected prices the remainder of the marketing year. Crops without monthly data are based on special surveys.

United States marketing year average prices are calculated by weighting monthly U.S. prices by monthly marketings for corn, sorghum, oats, barley, wheat, rice, soybeans, flaxseed, peanuts, upland cotton, and sunflower. Estimates for other commodities are computed by weighting State marketing year averages to the US level. Marketings for the States in the monthly price program generally account for at least 90 percent of the total value of US marketings. See page 3 for a listing of States in the monthly program for each crop concerned.

Value of production is computed by multiplying each State price by its production. Value of production for the United States is the sum of State values for all States listed for the crop. Value of production estimates in this report relate to the crop year and should not be confused with cash receipts which relate to sales during a calendar year, irrespective of the year of production. The next issue of this report will be published January 1992.

MARKETING YEAR AVERAGE PRICES

Marketing year average prices received by farmers at the United States level for the crops listed below are based on US monthly prices weighted by monthly marketings during specific periods. These periods, by crop, are shown below. US monthly prices are State average prices weighted by marketings during the month. The States included in monthly surveys generally account for 90 percent or more of total marketings and are shown in the table below.
