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BUTTER: Butter production in the United States during June 1972 is estimated at 111,146,000 pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is a decline of 7 percent from a month earlier and 1 percent less than June 1971. In 1971, the seasonal decrease was 5 percent from May to June. In the 4 leading butter-producing States, production decreased 8 percent from May in Minnesota, 5 percent in Wisconsin, and 3 percent in Iowa, while California was up slightly. Compared with a year earlier, June production was down 7 percent in Minnesota, but up 4 percent in Wisconsin, 16 percent in California and 2 percent in Iowa.

CHEESE: June production of American cheese totaled 176,361,000 pounds, highest production for any month on record. Output in June was 8 percent above a year earlier and 17 percent above June 1970. The seasonal increase from May to June this year amounted to 2 percent, compared with 4 percent in 1971 and 2 percent in 1970. Wisconsin output increased 5 percent from May. Compared with June 1971, American cheese production was higher in all important producing States except Illinois, Missouri, South Dakota, and Tennessee, which showed declines. Wisconsin output of American cheese was 8 percent more than a year earlier.

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Production of miscellaneous types of cheese totaled 81,535,000 pounds in June, a record high for the month. Output was 12 percent above June 1971 and 22 percent greater than June 1970. Production was larger than a year earlier for all types except Neufchatel, which was unchanged. June combined production for all types gained 4 percent from May. A year earlier, the change was an increase of less than 1 percent. Declines in Brick and Munster, Italian types, and Blue cheese from May were more than offset by increases in other types of miscellaneous cheese.

COTTAGE CHEESE: Production of cottage cheese curd during June was estimated at 68,382,000 pounds--a new record high for the month. Output was up 7 percent from June 1971 and 4 percent from two years ago. From May to June, production decreased 5 percent this year and 3 percent in 1971, but increased 2 percent in 1970.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 91,783,000 pounds--also a record high for the month. This year's June production was 6 percent larger than last year and 3 percent more than two years earlier. Output declined 5 percent from May to June this year. Last year production decreased 2 percent from May to June, but increased 2 percent in 1970.

FROZEN DESSERTS: Production of ice cream during June was estimated at 80,090,000 gallons--a new record high for the month. Output was 4 percent more than in June a year ago and 7 percent larger than in 1970. The seasonal increase from May to June this year was 14 percent, compared to 21 percent last year and 10 percent two years ago. In the three leading ice cream-producing States, output was above a year ago by 2 percent in Pennsylvania and 6 percent in California, but down 3 percent in New York. However, New York ranked first in June production.

Ice milk production for June was estimated at 33,431,000 gallons, 3 percent smaller than in 1971 and down fractionally from two years earlier. From May to June this year, output increased 10 percent. This compares with gains of 26 percent in 1971 and 12 percent in 1970.

Output of sherbet totaled 5,605,000 gallons, down 3 percent from June 1971 and 1 percent from two years ago. From May to June, output increased 16 percent this year, 29 percent a year ago and 15 percent in 1970.

Mellorine production was estimated at 4,776,000 gallons, 7 percent less than in June a year earlier and 10 percent less than in 1970. From May to June, output increased 9 percent this year, 18 percent in 1971 and 9 percent in 1970.

CANNED MILK: Production of canned evaporated and condensed whole milk totaled 130.8 million pounds in June, 5 percent above a month earlier, but 8 percent below June 1971. Manufacturers' stocks of canned whole milk increased 15 percent during June but were 8 percent less than a year earlier. Manufacturers' selling prices for canned evaporated whole milk were reported at \$7.70-\$9.08 per case in June compared with \$7.67-\$9.10 a month earlier and \$6.95-\$8.30 in June 1971.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: Production of nonfat dry milk for human food is estimated at 160.0 million pounds for June, 5 percent above May, but 7 percent below June 1971. Manufacturers' stocks of nonfat dry milk totaled 106.0 million pounds at the end of June. This is an increase of 14 percent over a month earlier, but 30 percent less than stocks at the end of June 1971. Manufacturers' selling prices for bulk goods averaged 31.75 cents per pound in June, up 0.03 cent from May, but unchanged from June 1971.

Dry whole milk production in June, at 7.3 million pounds, was 14 percent less than the previous month and 8 percent below June 1971. Manufacturers' stocks at the end of June amounted to 7.6 million pounds, 36 percent more than a month earlier, but 16 percent below a year earlier. Manufacturers' selling prices for bulk goods averaged 47.03 cents per pound in June, down 0.15 cent from May, but 0.70 cent above the average for June 1971.

Output of dry buttermilk totaled 4.6 million pounds in June, a decline of 14 percent from the previous month and 6 percent below June 1971. Manufacturers' stocks on June 30 amounted to 6.0 million pounds, 4 percent below the May 31 total and 9 percent below a year earlier. Manufacturers' selling prices for dry buttermilk for human food averaged 30.40 cents per pound in June compared with 28.36 cents in June 1971.

MILK PRICES: Prices to producers for manufacturing grade milk used at butter-powder plants averaged \$4.79 per 100 pounds in June, down 7 cents from May, but up 9 cents from June a year earlier. The average milkfat test decreased seasonally from 3.55 percent in May to 3.48 percent in June. The price per pound of milkfat averaged \$1.38. This compares with \$1.37 in May and \$1.35 in June 1971.

At American cheese plants, prices of manufacturing grade milk averaged \$4.95. This is 1 cent below the preceding month, but 18 cents above June a year ago. The June fat test averaged 3.57 percent, down from the 3.61 percent for May. The equivalent price per pound of milkfat at \$1.39, increased from the \$1.37 per pound in May and the \$1.34 per pound in June 1971.

Manufacturing grade milk used at miscellaneous-type cheese plants averaged \$5.07 per 100 pounds. This compares with \$5.10 in May and \$4.87 a year ago. The June fat test at 3.54 percent was down from the 3.60 percent for the preceding month. The price per pound of milkfat in June was \$1.43, an increase of 1 cent over May and 5 cents above June 1971.

Prices paid to producers for manufacturing grade milk used for canning by condenseries averaged \$4.53 per hundredweight in June, down 5 cents from May. The test of producer milk in June averaged 3.59 percent compared with 3.62 in May and 3.64 in June 1971. The equivalent price per pound of milkfat declined 1 cent from May to \$1.26 in June, 1 cent per pound above a year earlier.
