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JUNE HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in June is estimated at 87.6 million pounds, 13 percent less than May and 20 percent below June 1972. Output declined in all major States.

American cheese production in June was 172 million pounds, about the same as May, but 1 percent below June 1972.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in June amounted to 89.2 million pounds, up 8 percent from June 1972. All miscellaneous types increased over a year ago.

Cottage cheese: Creamed cottage output in June totaled 87.3 million pounds, down 1 percent from June 1972.

Lowfat cottage amounted to 11.6 million pounds, 29 percent above a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 114.6 million pounds, down 6 percent from a year earlier.

Frozen Desserts (June 1973 production compared with June 1972)

Ice cream -- 79.7 million gallons, up 1 percent.

Ice milk -- 33.8 million gallons, up 1 percent.

Sherbet -- 6.5 million gallons, up 11 percent.

Mellorine -- 4.5 million gallons, down 10 percent.

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Dry Milk Products (June 1973 production compared with June 1972)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--119 million pounds, down 23 percent.

Dry whole milk--9.3 million pounds, up 27 percent.

Dry buttermilk--3.7 million pounds, down 21 percent.

Dry whey for human food--39.4 million pounds, up 14 percent.

Dry whey for animal feed--35.2 million pounds, down 7 percent.

Condensed whey--22.5 million pounds, up 32 percent.

Milk Prices for manufacturing grade milk in June used primarily for production of:

Butter powder--\$5.47, down 1 cent from May, but up 67 cents from a year ago.

American Cheese--\$5.71, up 4 cents from May and 76 cents from a year ago.

Miscellaneous Cheese--\$5.76, down 3 cents from May, but up 69 cents from a year ago.

Evaporated Milk (Canned)--\$5.12, up 3 cents from May and 53 cents from a year ago.
