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JULY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in July is estimated at 69.1 million pounds, a 21 percent decrease from both June 1973 and July 1972. Output continued to decline in all major States.

American cheese production in July was 155 million pounds--down 10 percent from June and 2 percent from July 1972.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in July amounted to 83.4 million pounds--down 7 percent from last month, but up 9 percent from July 1972.

Cottage cheese: Creamed cottage output in July totaled 82.9 million pounds--down 1 percent from July 1972.
Lowfat cottage amounted to 10.3 million pounds, 22 percent above a year ago.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 101 million pounds, 10 percent lower than a year earlier.

Frozen Desserts (July 1973 production compared with July 1972)

Ice cream -- 78.8 million gallons, up 5 percent.
Ice milk -- 34.1 million gallons, down 1 percent.
Sherbet -- 6.4 million gallons, up 15 percent.
Mellorine -- 4.5 million gallons, down 6 percent.

Dry Milk Products (July 1973 production compared with July 1972)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 87.1 million pounds, down 28 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 6.4 million pounds, up 40 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3 million pounds, down 19 percent.

Dry whey for human food -- 33.7 million pounds, up 4 percent.

Dry whey for animal feed -- 31.5 million pounds, down 9 percent.

Condensed whey -- 19.3 million pounds, up 30 percent.

Milk Prices for manufacturing grade milk in July used primarily for production of:

Butter powder -- \$5.55, up 8 cents from June and 72 cents from a year ago.

American cheese -- \$5.73, an increase of 2 cents from June and 76 cents from a year ago.

Miscellaneous cheese -- \$5.83, up 7 cents from June and 74 cents from a year ago.

Evaporated milk (canned) -- \$5.36, up 24 cents from June and 75 cents from a year ago.
