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SEPTEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in September is estimated at 51.3 million pounds--the lowest for any month of record since February 1920. Output was 12 percent less than August and 23 percent less than September 1972. This downward trend continued in all major States.

American cheese production in September was 110 million pounds--down 20 percent from August and 11 percent from September 1972.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in September amounted to 76.2 million pounds-- down 6 percent from last month, but up 1 percent from September 1972.

Cottage Cheese: Creamed cottage output totaled 72.9 million pounds--down 11 percent from September 1972. Lowfat Cottage amounted to 9.1 million pounds, 6 percent above a year ago.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in September was 83.9 million pounds, 5 percent lower than a year earlier.

Ice cream--68.4 million gallons, down 2 percent.
Ice milk--25.2 million gallons, down 2 percent.
Sherbet--4.6 million gallons, up 2 percent.
Mellorine--3.4 million gallons, down 15 percent.

Dry buttermilk--2.1 million pounds, down 27 percent.

Dry whey for human food--27.5 million pounds, down 5 percent.

Dry whey for animal feed--26.0 million pounds, down 18 percent.

Condensed whey--15.0 million pounds, up 11 percent.

Milk Prices for manufacturing grade milk in September used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$6.85, up 62 cents from August and \$1.83 from a year ago.

American cheese--\$6.97, up 65 cents from August and \$1.79 from a year ago.

Miscellaneous cheese--\$7.03, up 64 cents from August and \$1.77 from a year ago.

Evaporated milk (canned)--\$6.19, up 43 cents from August and \$1.49 from a year ago.
