Butter production in May was estimated at 99.8 million pounds, 13 percent above April and about the same as a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 185 million pounds, the highest production for any month of record. Production was up 4 percent from April and 7 percent from May 1973.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in May amounted to 91.3 million pounds, about the same as last month but 1 percent below a year ago.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 79.5 million pounds--down 10 percent from May last year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 11.4 million pounds, 3 percent below May 1973.

IN THIS ISSUE

Monthly production data have been revised for 1973, and in some cases for 1972. These revisions are based on an annual review using reports from all dairy plants. Revised monthly production data for 1973 are shown by States in the annual report, "Production of Manufactured Dairy Products, 1973", which is available on request.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in May was 100 million pounds, a drop of 16 percent from the previous year.

Frozen Desserts (May 1974 production compared with May 1973)

Ice cream -- 69.7 million gallons, up 3 percent.

Ice milk -- 29.3 million gallons, about the same.

Sherbet -- 5.0 million gallons, down 3 percent.

Mellorine -- 3.6 million gallons, down 10 percent.

Dry milk products (May 1974 production compared with May 1973)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 121.2 million pounds, up 2 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 9.7 million pounds, up 4 percent.

Dry whey for human food -- 42.2 million pounds, up 18 percent.

Dry whey for animal feed -- 37.7 million pounds, up 1 percent.

Condensed whey -- 29.3 million pounds, up 33 percent.

Milk Prices for manufacturing grade milk in May used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder -- \$6.75, down 92 cents from April, but up \$1.27 from May 1973.

American cheese -- \$6.94, down 92 cents from April, but up \$1.27 from May 1973.

Miscellaneous cheese -- \$7.04, down \$1.00 from April, but up \$1.25 from May 1973.

Evaporated milk (canned) -- \$7.16, down 38 cents from April, but up \$2.07 from May 1973.
