JUNE HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in June was estimated at 91.8 million pounds, 8 percent below May but 5 percent above a year earlier. This is the first increase in butter production from the same month a year earlier since February 1972.

American cheese output totaled 184 million pounds, down 1 percent from May but up 5 percent from the previous year.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in June amounted to 91.9 million pounds, a 1 percent increase from both May 1974 and June 1973.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 71.5 million pounds--down 16 percent from June last year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 10.2 million pounds, 12 percent below June last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in June was 103 million pounds, a drop of 11 percent from the previous year.

Frozen Desserts (June 1974 production compared with June 1973)

Ice cream -- 76.3 million gallons, down 3 percent.

Ice milk -- 31.3 million gallons, down 9 percent.

Sherbet -- 5.6 million gallons, down 11 percent.

Mellorine -- 3.5 million gallons, down 20 percent.

Dry whole milk--8.4 million pounds, down 10 percent.

Dry whey for human food--41.5 million pounds, up 12 percent.

Dry whey for animal feed--42.7 million pounds, up 23 percent.

Condensed whey--29.7 million pounds, up 39 percent.

Milk Prices for manufacturing grade milk in June used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$6.28, down 47 cents from May, but up 80 cents from June 1973.

American cheese--\$6.38, down 56 cents from May, but up 67 cents from June 1973.

Miscellaneous cheese--\$6.52, down 52 cents from May, but up 72 cents from June 1973.

Evaporated milk (canned)--\$6.79, down 37 cents from May, but up \$1.71 from June 1973.
