JULY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in July was estimated at 78.4 million pounds, 15 percent below June but 16 percent above a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 165 million pounds, the highest July production on record. Production was 11 percent below June but 8 percent above July 1973.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in July amounted to 85.9 million pounds, down 7 percent from last month but up 4 percent from July last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 75.8 million pounds--a drop of 9 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 10.5 million pounds, down 2 percent from July last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in July was 101 million pounds, approximately the same as a year ago.

Frozen Desserts (July 1974 production compared with July 1973)

Ice cream--79.0 million gallons, about the same.

Ice milk--33.9 million gallons, down 2 percent.

Sherbet--6.1 million gallons, down 5 percent.

Mellorine--3.4 million gallons, down 22 percent.

Dry milk products (July 1974 production compared with July 1973)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--117 million pounds, up 36 percent.
Dry whole milk--6.5 million pounds, up 20 percent.
Dry whey for human food--34.1 million pounds, up 5 percent.
Dry whey for animal feed--34.2 million pounds, about the same.
Condensed whey--27.6 million pounds, up 55 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in July used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$6.24, down 4 cents from June but up 59 cents from July 1973.
American cheese--\$6.27, down 11 cents from June, but up 47 cents from July 1973.
Miscellaneous cheese--\$6.35, down 17 cents from June, but up 45 cents from July 1973.
Evaporated milk(canned)--\$6.70, down 9 cents from June but up \$1.40 from July 1973.
