SEPTEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in September was estimated at 65.4 million pounds, 11 percent below August but 28 percent above a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 123 million pounds, 14 percent below August but 9 percent above September 1973.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in September amounted to 87.7 million pounds, up 1 percent from last month and 19 percent above September last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 69.0 million pounds--a drop of 5 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 9.8 million pounds, down 1 percent from September last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in September was 65.1 million pounds, down 19 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (September 1974 production compared with September 1973)
Ice cream -- 68.5 million gallons, up 3 percent.
Ice milk -- 25.4 million gallons, up 1 percent.
Sherbet -- 4.0 million gallons, down 8 percent.
Mellorine -- 2.8 million gallons, down 17 percent.

Dry milk products (September 1974 production compared with September 1973)
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 64.7 million pounds, up 31 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 2.9 million pounds, down 45 percent.
Dry whey for human food -- 31.5 million pounds, up 24 percent.
Dry whey for animal feed -- 29.6 million pounds, up 2 percent.
Condensed whey -- 23.4 million pounds, up 73 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in September used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder -- \$6.63, up 23 cents from August but 35 cents below September 1973.

American cheese -- \$6.80, up 38 cents from August, but 24 cents below September 1973.

Miscellaneous cheese -- \$6.95, up 43 cents from August but 15 cents below a year earlier.

Evaporated milk (canned) -- \$6.96, up 20 cents from August and 74 cents from last September.
