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OCTOBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in October was estimated at 70.8 million pounds, 8 percent above September and 12 percent above a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 125 million pounds, 1 percent above September and 2 percent above October 1973.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in October amounted to 91.5 million pounds, up 4 percent from last month and 14 percent from October last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 70.7 million pounds--a drop of 7 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 10.1 million pounds, down 3 percent from October last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in October was 55.8 million pounds, down 30 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (October 1974 production compared with October 1973)

Ice cream-- 63.3 million gallons, up 1 percent.

Ice milk-- 21.6 million gallons, down 3 percent.

Sherbet-- 3.5 million gallons, down 9 percent.

Mellorine-- 2.6 million gallons, down 21 percent.

Dry milk products (October 1974 production compared with October 1973)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 58.3 million pounds, up 7 percent.
 Dry whole milk -- 2.9 million pounds, down 41 percent.
 Dry whey for human food -- 30.8 million pounds, up 12 percent.
 Dry whey for animal feed -- 31.9 million pounds, up 6 percent.
 Condensed whey -- 23.0 million pounds, up 42 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in October used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder -- \$6.88, up 25 cents from September but 54 cents below October 1973.
 American cheese -- \$7.08, up 28 cents from September, but 51 cents below October 1973.
 Miscellaneous cheese -- \$7.21, up 26 cents from September but 40 cents below a year earlier.
 Evaporated milk (canned) -- \$7.03, up 7 cents from September and 20 cents from last October.
