NOVEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in November was estimated at 68.0 million pounds, 4 percent below October but 13 percent above a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 115 million pounds, 8 percent below October and 7 percent below November 1973.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in November amounted to 90.7 million pounds, down 1 percent from last month but 11 percent above November last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 66.4 million pounds -- a drop of 4 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 9.2 million pounds, down 1 percent from November last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in October was 61.1 million pounds, down 16 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (November 1974 production compared with November 1973)

Ice cream -- 55.7 million gallons, up 3 percent.
Ice milk -- 17.9 million gallons, up 7 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.8 million gallons, down 13 percent.
Mellorine -- 2.1 million gallons, down 20 percent.

Dry milk products (November 1974 production compared with November 1973)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 52.8 million pounds, up 20 percent.
 Dry whole milk -- 2.6 million pounds, down 43 percent.
 Dry whey for human food -- 27.8 million pounds, down 9 percent.
 Dry whey for animal feed -- 29.4 million pounds, down 1 percent.
 Condensed whey -- 22.7 million pounds, up 23 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in November used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$6.94, up 6 cents from October, but 69 cents below November 1973.
 American cheese--\$6.99, down 9 cents from October and 94 cents below November 1973.
 Miscellaneous cheese--\$7.13, down 8 cents from October and 83 cents below a year earlier.
 Evaporated milk (canned)--\$7.06, up 3 cents from October, but down 8 cents from last November.
