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## FEBRUARY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in February was estimated at 90.4 million pounds, 7 percent below the previous month but 31 percent above a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

American cheese output totaled 122 million pounds, 6 percent below January and 20 percent below February 1974.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in February totaled 81.8 million pounds, down 5 percent from last month but up 4 percent from February last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output was 68.9 million pounds--approximately the same as a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 9.8 million pounds, down 4 percent from February last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in February was 70.2 million pounds, down 10 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (February 1975 production compared with February 1974)

Ice cream -- 59.9 million gallons, up 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 18.3 million gallons, down 7 percent.

Sherbet -- 3.2 million gallons, down 6 percent.

Mellorine -- 2.4 million gallons, down 14 percent.

### IN THIS ISSUE

A new monthly series of production and prices of condensed whey and dry whey products starting January 1975 appear in this report on page 3. Stocks of dry whey products planned to be included in this publication will be published in future issues if more complete data become available.

The series of condensed whey production formerly reported on a wet basis was discontinued with December 1974. The 1975 data are in terms of pounds of solids in condensed whey.

Dry milk products (February 1975 production compared with February 1974)  
 Nonfat dry milk for human food--81.6 million pounds, up 46 percent.  
 Dry whole milk--3.9 million pounds, down 37 percent.  
 Dry buttermilk--4.1 million pounds, up 86 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in February used primarily for production of:  
 Butter-powder--\$6.99, the same as January but \$1.02 below February 1974.  
 American cheese--\$7.02, up 4 cents from January but \$1.32 below last February.  
 Miscellaneous cheese--\$7.14, up 3 cents from January but down \$1.25 from February 1974.  
 Evaporated milk (canned)--\$7.14, up 2 cents from January but 52 cents below February 1974.
