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MARCH HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in March was estimated at 96.3 million pounds, 7 percent above the previous month and 24 percent above March 1974, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

American cheese output totaled 144 million pounds, 18 percent above February but 20 percent below a year earlier.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in March amounted to 93.9 million pounds, up 15 percent from last month and 5 percent from March last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 77 million pounds--an increase of 1 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 10.7 million pounds, approximately the same as a year ago.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in March was 75 million pounds, down 19 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (March 1975 production compared with March 1974)

Ice cream -- 70.1 million gallons, up 7 percent.

Ice milk -- 22.4 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Sherbet -- 4 million gallons, down 6 percent.

Mellorine -- 2.7 million gallons, down 15 percent.
