MAY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in May was estimated at 102 million pounds, 1 percent above the previous month but 1 percent below a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 168 million pounds, 10 percent above April but 12 percent below May 1974.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in May amounted to 95.8 million pounds, a 6 percent increase from both April 1975 and May 1974.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 81.3 million pounds--an increase of 5 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 11.9 million pounds, up 5 percent from last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in May was 96.6 million pounds, down 11 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (May 1975 production compared with May 1974)

Ice cream--77.1 million gallons, up 11 percent.

Ice milk--30.9 million gallons, up 5 percent.

Sherbet--4.8 million gallons, down 5 percent.

Mellorine--3.0 million gallons, down 11 percent.

IN THIS ISSUE

Monthly production data have been revised for 1974, and in some cases for 1973. These revisions are based on an annual review using reports from all dairy plants. These revisions are shown in the annual report "Production of Manufactured Dairy Products, 1974", which is available on request.
