JUNE HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in June was estimated at 88.3 million pounds, 13 percent below the previous month and 7 percent below a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

American cheese output totaled 171 million pounds, 1 percent above May but 9 percent below June 1974.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in June amounted to 103 million pounds, up 7 percent from last month and 15 percent from June last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 76.9 million pounds--an increase of 9 percent from the previous year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production amounted to 11.0 million pounds, up 5 percent from June last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in June was 97.1 million pounds, down 5 percent from a year ago.

Frozen desserts (June 1975 production compared with June 1974)

Ice cream--84.3 million gallons, up 11 percent.

Ice milk--33.1 million gallons, up 3 percent.

Sherbet--5.8 million gallons, up 1 percent.

Mellorine--3.2 million gallons, down 13 percent.
