## SEPTEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in September was estimated at 57 million pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 3 percent below the previous month and 11 percent below a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 116 million pounds, 14 percent below August, and 8 percent below September 1974.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in September amounted to 97.4 million pounds, an increase of 5 percent from last month and 10 percent from last year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 72.2 million pounds, up 5 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 10.3 million pounds, up 6 percent from September last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in September was 73.7 million pounds, up 12 percent from the previous year.

Frozen desserts (September 1975 production compared with September 1974)

Ice cream--75.6 million gallons, up 8 percent.

Ice milk--24.9 million gallons, down 3 percent.

Sherbet--4.1 million gallons, approximately the same as last year.

Mellorine--2.5 million gallons, down 15 percent.

Dry milk products (September 1975 production compared with September 1974)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--53.2 million pounds, down 23 percent.

Dry whole milk--4.2 million pounds, up 36 percent.

Dry buttermilk--2.0 million pounds, down 23 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in September used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$8.23, up 72 cents from August and \$1.56 from September 1974.

American cheese--\$8.35, up 64 cents from August and \$1.53 from September 1974.

Miscellaneous cheese--\$8.47, up 62 cents from August and \$1.56 from September 1974.

Evaporated milk (canned)--\$7.71, up 40 cents from August and 77 cents from September 1974.
