OCTOBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in October was estimated at 67 million pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was an increase of 17 percent over the previous month but 6 percent below a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 121 million pounds, an increase of 4 percent from last month but 4 percent below September 1974.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production in October amounted to 97.9 million pounds, 1 percent above last month and 6 percent above the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 73.5 million pounds, up 4 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 9.9 million pounds, down 3 percent from October last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk in October was 68.7 million pounds, up 13 percent from the previous year.

Frozen desserts (October 1975 production compared with October 1974)

Ice cream--67.1 million gallons, up 6 percent.

Ice milk--21.9 million gallons, up 2 percent.

Sherbet--3.3 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Mellorine--2.4 million gallons, down 7 percent.

Dry milk products (October 1975 production compared with October 1974)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--50.3 million pounds, down 8 percent.

Dry whole milk--5.4 million pounds, up 49 percent.

Dry buttermilk--2.3 million pounds, down 29 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in October used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$8.80, up 57 cents from September and \$1.86 from October 1974.

American cheese--\$8.84, up 49 cents from September and \$1.76 from October 1974.

Miscellaneous cheese--\$8.98, up 51 cents from September and \$1.83 from October 1974.

Evaporated milk (canned)--\$8.13, up 42 cents from September and \$1.11 from October 1974.
