NOVEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in November was estimated at 65 million pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 3 percent below the previous month and 4 percent below November 1974.

American cheese output was 117 million pounds, a decrease of 3 percent from last month but approximately the same as last year.

Miscellaneous types of cheese output totaled 93.9 million pounds, 4 percent below last month but 6 percent above the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 65.2 million pounds, down 2 percent from November last year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 9.3 million pounds, up 1 percent from a year ago.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk in November was 64.3 million pounds, up 6 percent from the previous year.

Frozen desserts (November 1975 production compared with November 1974).

- Ice cream--57.8 million gallons, up 5 percent.
- Ice milk --16.3 million gallons, down 3 percent.
- Sherbet --2.7 million gallons, down 1 percent.
- Mellorine--1.6 million gallons, down 28 percent.

Dry milk products (November 1975 production compared with November 1974).

- Nonfat dry milk for human food--49.3 million pounds, down 4 percent.
- Dry whole milk--5.3 million pounds, up 88 percent.
- Dry buttermilk--2.0 million pounds, down 28 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in November used primarily for production of:

- Butter-powder--\$9.10, up 30 cents from October and \$2.14 from November 1974.
- American cheese--\$9.06, up 22 cents from October and \$2.04 from November 1974.
- Miscellaneous cheese--\$9.18, up 20 cents from October and \$2.07 from November 1974.
- Evaporated milk (canned)--\$8.43, up 30 cents from October and \$1.35 from November 1974.
