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DECEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in December was estimated at 83.0 million pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 28 percent above the previous month but 7 percent below a year earlier.

American cheese output totaled 136 million pounds, 16 percent above last month and 9 percent above December 1974.

Miscellaneous types of cheese production totaled 103 million pounds, up 9 percent from last month and 10 percent from the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese output totaled 65.3 million pounds, up 7 percent from December last year.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 8.9 million pounds, up 9 percent from a year ago.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production in December was 74.6 million pounds, down 4 percent from the previous year.

Frozen desserts (December 1975 production compared with December 1974).

Ice cream--57.9 million gallons, up 10 percent and the highest December output on record.

Ice milk--15.8 million gallons, up 4 percent.

Sherbet--3.0 million gallons, up 10 percent.

Mellorine--1.5 million gallons, down 16 percent.

Dry milk products (December 1975 production compared with December 1974).

Nonfat dry milk for human food--67.1 million pounds, down 19 percent.

Dry whole milk--6.8 million pounds, up 45 percent.

Dry buttermilk--3.5 million pounds, down 24 percent.

Milk prices for manufacturing grade milk in December used primarily for production of:

Butter-powder--\$9.32, up 22 cents from November and \$2.62 from December 1974.

American cheese--\$9.35, up 29 cents from November and \$2.66 from December 1974.

Miscellaneous cheese--\$9.42, up 24 cents from November and \$2.56 from December 1974.

Evaporated milk (canned)--\$8.75, up 32 cents from November and \$1.64 from December 1974.
