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JANUARY PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production 94.3 million pounds, 14 percent above the previous month but 3 percent under January 1975.

American cheese, 149 million pounds, up 10 percent from last month and 14 percent from a year earlier.

Miscellaneous types of cheese, 99.7 million pounds, down 3 percent from the previous month, but 16 percent above January 1975.

Creamed cottage cheese, 70.5 million pounds, down 2 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 11.0 million pounds, up 11 percent from a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 76.2 million pounds, up 3 percent from January 1975.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with January 1975)

Ice cream, 55.8 million gallons, down 5 percent. This is the first decrease from the same month a year earlier since June 1974.

Ice milk, 15.5 million gallons, down 11 percent.

Sherbet, 3.1 million gallons, down 7 percent.

Mellorine, 1.9 million gallons, down 13 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with January 1975)

Nonfat dry milk for human food, 67.0 million pounds, down 20 percent.

Dry whole milk, 7.4 million pounds, up 53 percent.

Dry buttermilk, 3.9 million pounds, down 15 percent.

American cheese, \$9.11, down 24 cents from the previous month, but \$2.13 above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$9.26, down 16 cents from December, but \$2.15 above January 1975.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$8.67, down 8 cents from last month, but \$1.55 above the previous year.
