PRODUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production, 89.3 million pounds, up 5 percent from the previous month, but 7 percent under March 1975.

American cheese, 166 million pounds, up 11 percent from last month and 15 percent from a year earlier.

Miscellaneous types of cheese, 109 million pounds, up 19 percent from the previous month and 16 percent above March 1975.

Creamed cottage cheese, 82.7 million pounds, up 7 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 12.8 million pounds, up 19 percent from a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 86.6 million pounds, up 16 percent from March 1975.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with March 1975)

Ice cream, 73.1 million gallons, up 4 percent and the highest March output on record.

Ice milk, 24.5 million gallons, up 10 percent.

Sherbet, 4.4 million gallons, up 9 percent.

Mellorine, 2.3 million gallons, down 14 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with March 1975)

Nonfat dry milk for human food, 78.4 million pounds, down 18 percent.

Dry whole milk, 6.5 million pounds, up 93 percent.

Dry buttermilk, 3.9 million pounds, up 3 percent.

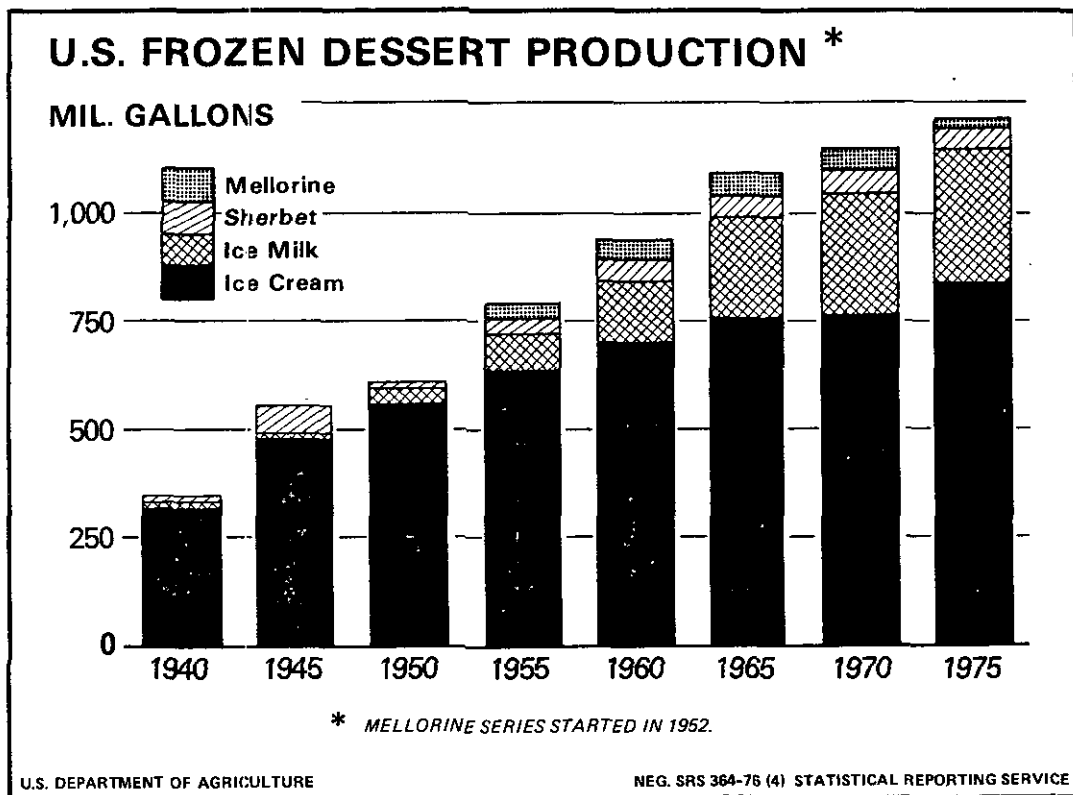
MANUFACTURING GRADE PRICES

Butter-powder, \$8.47, up 13 cents from February and \$1.56 above March 1975.

American cheese, \$8.63, up 16 cents from the previous month and \$1.61 above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$8.74, up 12 cents from February and \$1.59 above March 1975.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$8.13, down 18 cents from last month, but \$1.05 above the previous year.
