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MAY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in the United States was 94 million pounds in May, up 7 percent from April, but down 7 percent from May 1975.

American type cheese, 204 million pounds, up 9 percent from last month and 20 percent from a year earlier. This is the highest monthly production on record.

Total cheese output was also a record high at 314 million pounds, up 6 percent from last month and 16 percent from a year earlier.

Creamed cottage cheese, 77.6 million pounds, down 2 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 12.1 million pounds, down 2 percent from a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 89.5 million pounds, down 9 percent from May 1975.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with May 1975)

Ice cream--68.9 million gallons, down 10 percent.

Ice milk--26.9 million gallons, down 15 percent.

Sherbet--4.8 million gallons, down 1 percent.

Mellorine--2.1 million gallons, down 32 percent.

Dry Milk Products: (Comparisons with May 1975)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--104.9 million pounds, down 17 percent.

Dry whole milk--9.8 million pounds, up 39 percent.

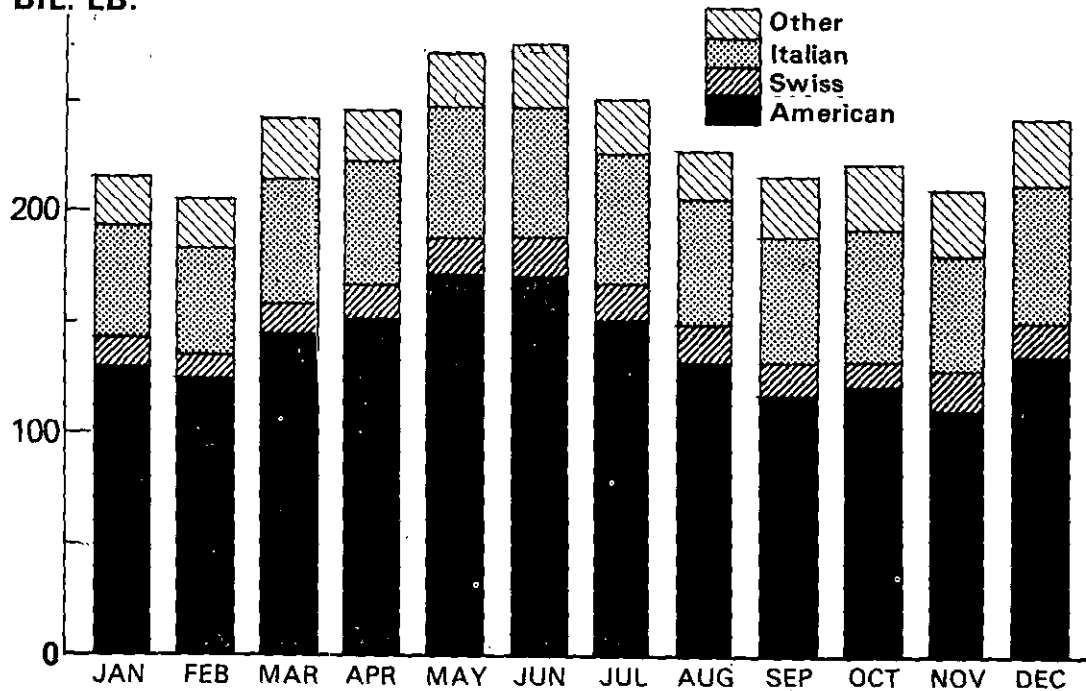
Dry buttermilk--4.5 million pounds, up 6 percent.

American cheese, \$8.36, down 23 cents from the previous month, but \$1.27 above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$8.57, down 18 cents from April, but \$1.34 above May 1975.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$7.95, down 13 cents from last month, but 98 cents above the previous year.
