

# DAIRY PRODUCTS

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## JUNE HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in the United States was 84.0 million pounds in June, down 11 percent from May and 4 percent from June 1975.

American type cheese, 207 million pounds, exceeds last month's record high output by 2 percent and was 22 percent above a year earlier.

Total cheese output was also a record high at 320 million pounds, up 2 percent from last month and 16 percent from a year earlier.

Creamed cottage cheese, 78.8 million pounds, up 3 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 12.2 million pounds, up 7 percent from a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 97.7 million pounds, down 2 percent from June 1975.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with June 1975)

Ice cream--80.9 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Ice milk --31.2 million gallons, down 7 percent.

Sherbet--6.0 million gallons, up 2 percent.

Mellorine--2.4 million gallons, down 27 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with June 1975)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--108.9 million pounds, down 11 percent.

Dry whole milk--8.0 million pounds, down 3 percent.

Dry buttermilk--4.2 million pounds, up 15 percent.

## MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

Butter-powder, \$8.21, down 1 cent from May, but up \$1.20 from June 1975.

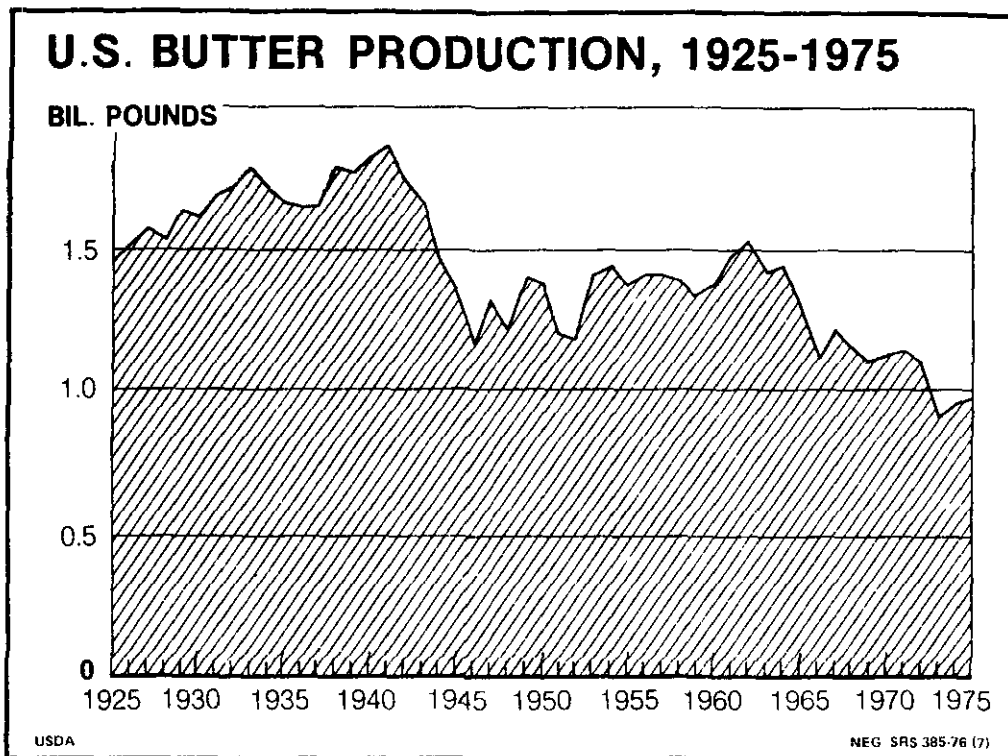
American cheese, \$8.42, up 6 cents from the previous month and \$1.27 above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$8.56, down 1 cent from May, but \$1.25 above June 1975.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$7.93, down 2 cents from last month, but \$1.00 above the previous year.

Estimates in this report are based on data provided by manufacturers of dairy products to the Statistical Reporting Service. In addition, State Departments of Agriculture in 32 States assist in collecting data. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. Reports are received from all dairy plants in those States with small numbers of plants, but in States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all plants in the larger size strata and from a sample of plants in the smaller size strata. Estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of plants which account for 75 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.
