

# DAIRY PRODUCTS

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## JANUARY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in the United States was 106 million pounds in January, the largest monthly production since June 1972. The January 1977 production was up 15 percent from December and 12 percent above January 1976.

American type cheese totaled 167 million pounds, 1 percent above last month and 12 percent above a year earlier.

Total cheese output was 265 million pounds, down 4 percent from the previous month but up 6 percent from the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese, 69.9 million pounds, down 1 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 11.4 million pounds, up 3 percent from a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 62.5 million pounds, down 18 percent from January 1976.

Frozen desserts: (comparisons with January 1976)

Ice cream--51.5 million gallons, down 8 percent.

Ice Milk--15.5 million gallons, slightly above a year earlier.

Sherbet--2.8 million gallons, down 8 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with January 1976)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--71.5 million pounds, up 7 percent.

Dry whole milk--6.1 million pounds, down 18 percent.

Dry buttermilk--5.3 million pounds, up 35 percent.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$8.45, up 2 cents from last month, but 22 cents below the previous year.
