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JUNE HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production in the United States was 95.0 million pounds in June, 9 percent less than May but 13 percent more than June 1976.

American type cheese totaled 200 million pounds, 5 percent below last month and 4 percent below a year earlier.

Total cheese output was 314 million pounds, down 4 percent from the previous month and 3 percent from the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese, 77.6 million pounds, off 1 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 12.2 million pounds, slightly below a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 80.2 million pounds, declined 13 percent from June 1976.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with June 1976)

Ice Cream--81.7 million gallons, down 2 percent

Ice Milk--33.4 million gallons, up 3 percent.

Sherbet--5.7 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with June 1976)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--133 million pounds, up 23 percent.

Dry whole milk--5.6 million pounds, down 30 percent.

Dry buttermilk--4.7 million pounds, up 19 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

Butter-powder, \$8.53, off 4 cents from May, but up 38 cents from June 1976.

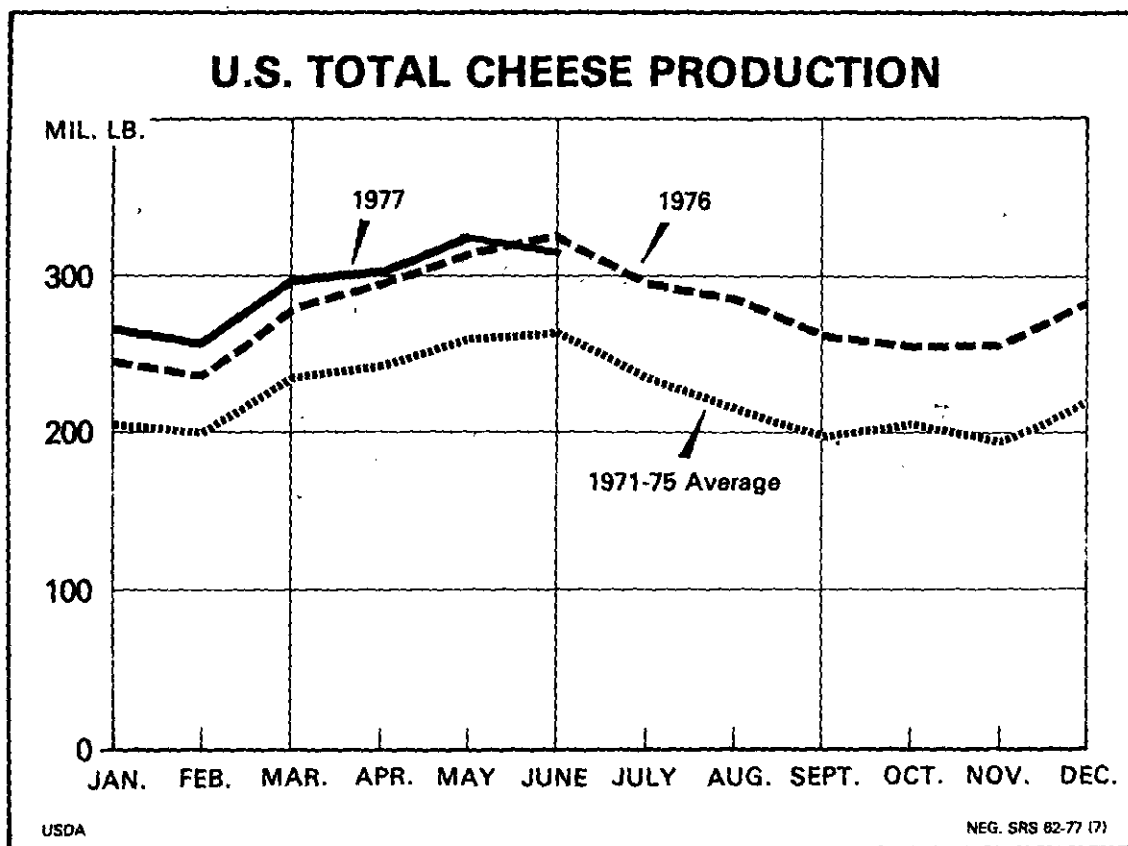
American cheese, \$8.58, down 6 cents from the previous month but 20 cents higher than the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$8.75, declined 12 cents from May but was 17 cents above June 1976.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$8.31, unchanged from last month, but 32 cents over the previous year.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
