NOVEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 66.7 million pounds in November, 6 percent less than October and 18 percent less than November 1977.

American type cheese totaled 154 million pounds, 3 percent below last month, but 13 percent above a year earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 276 million pounds, down 1 percent from the previous month, but 12 percent above the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese, 68.2 million pounds, down 2 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 11.6 million pounds, 6 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 52.3 million pounds, up 11 percent from November 1977.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with November 1977)

Ice cream -- 58.2 million gallons, up 3 percent.

Ice milk -- 18.1 million gallons, up 5 percent.

Sherbet -- 2.92 million gallons, down 1 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with November 1977)

Nonfat dry milk human food -- 41.9 million pounds, down 36 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 5.00 million pounds, up 18 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 2.83 million pounds, down 30 percent.

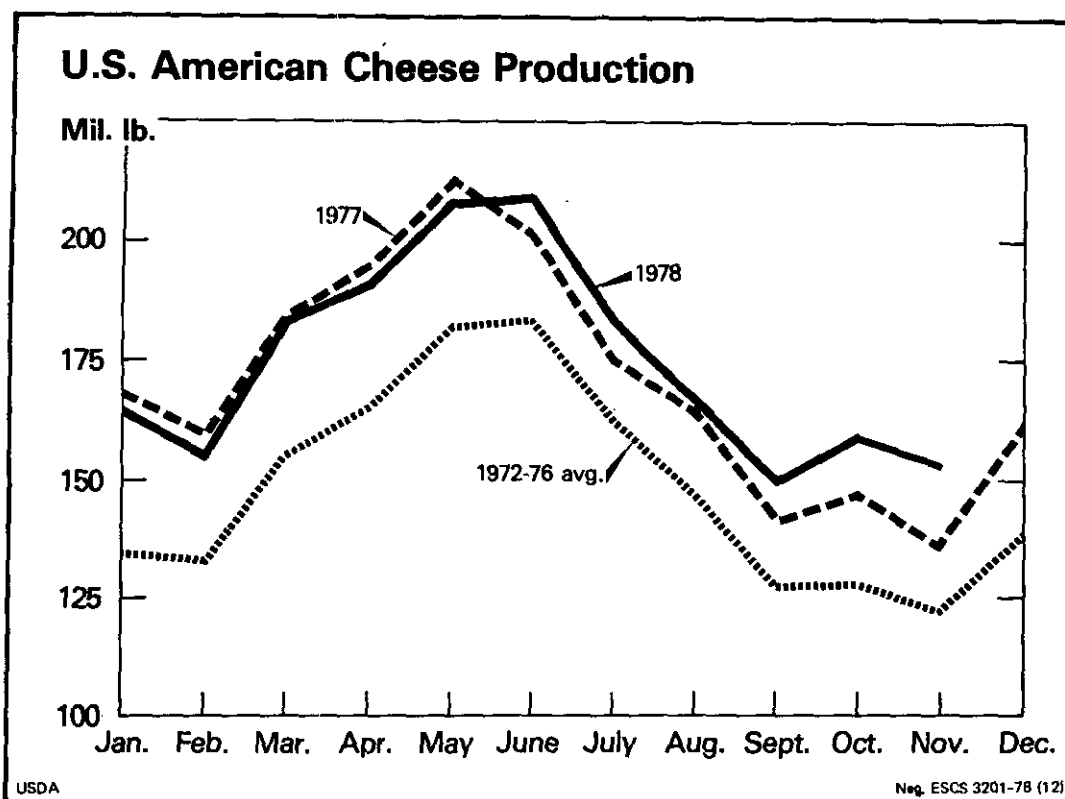
MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES CONTINUE TO INCREASE

Butter-powder, \$10.61, up 37 cents from October and \$1.63 above November 1977.

American cheese, \$10.80, an increase of 21 cents from the previous month and \$1.66 above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$10.91, up 22 cents from October and \$1.63 higher than October 1977.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$10.22, 35 cents above last month, and \$1.41 more than the previous year.
