MAY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 116 million pounds in May, 5 percent more than in April and 17 percent more than May 1979.

American type cheese totaled 230 million pounds, 13 percent above last month and 10 percent above a year earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 360 million pounds, up 8 percent from the previous month and 6 percent more than the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese, 74.6 million pounds, down 3 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 15.9 million pounds, 9 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 63.9 million pounds, down 22 percent from May 1979.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with May 1979)

Ice cream -- 73.0 million gallons, down 1 percent.

Ice milk -- 29.5 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.30 million gallons, down 3 percent.

Dry Milk Products: (Comparisons with May 1979)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 133 million pounds, up 23 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 5.70 million pounds, down 31 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 5.27 million pounds, up 17 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

Butter-powder, \$11.77, down 8 cents from April, but \$1.14 above May 1979.

American cheese, \$11.79, a decrease of 12 cents from the previous month, but 95 cents above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$11.94, down 13 cents from April, but 92 cents higher than May 1979.

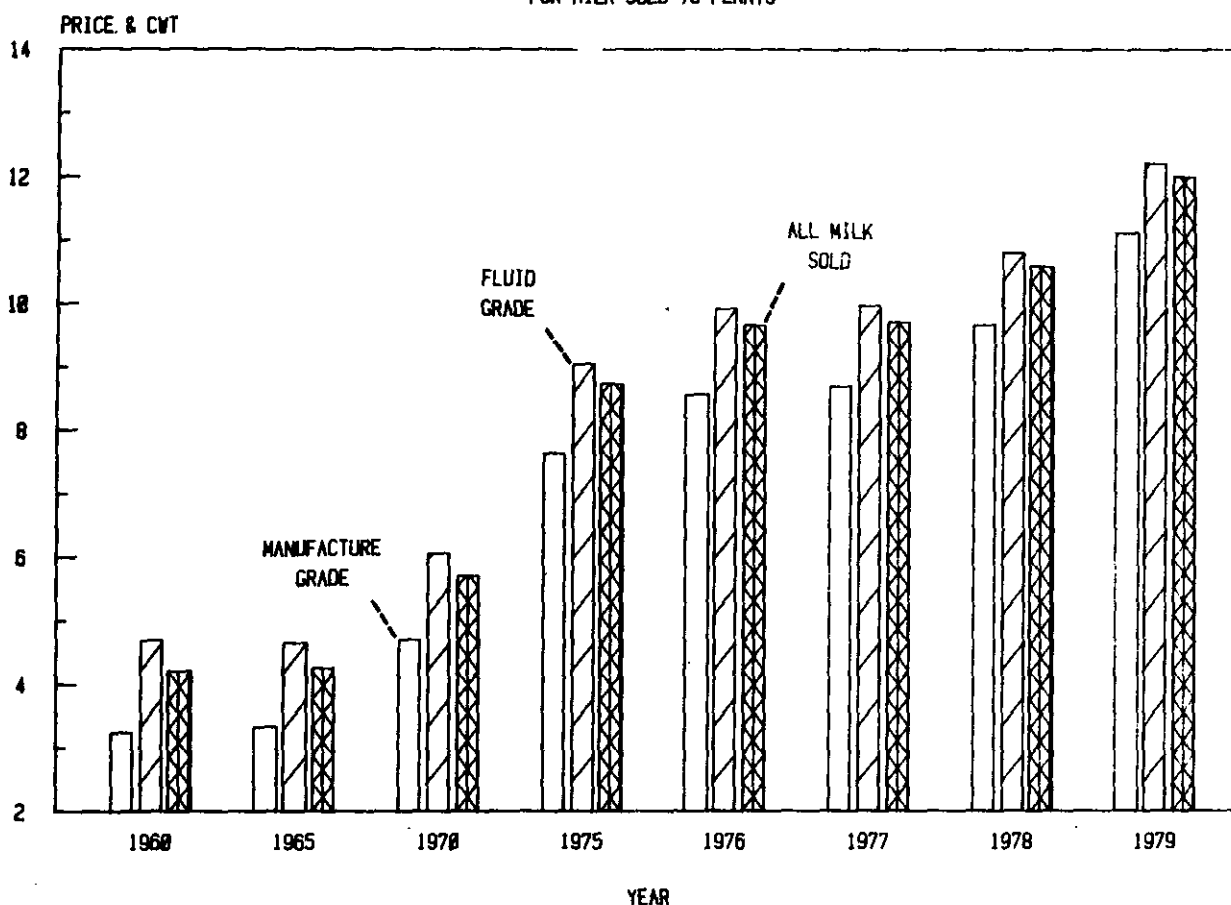
Evaporated milk (canned), \$11.18, 7 cents below last month, but 90 cents above the previous year.
