

DAIRY PRODUCTS

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SEPTEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 77.2 million pounds in September, 1 percent less than August but 28 percent more than September 1979.

American type cheese totaled 182 million pounds, 6 percent below last month but 8 percent above a year earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 315 million pounds, down 1 percent from the previous month but 8 percent above the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese, 70.7 million pounds, up 7 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 14.3 million pounds, 11 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 56.2 million pounds, down 10 percent from September 1979.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with September 1979)

Ice cream -- 73.9 million gallons, up 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 25.9 million gallons, up 1 percent.

Sherbet -- 3.88 million gallons, up 5 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with September 1979)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 75.8 million gallons, up 35 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 6.16 million pounds, up 11 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 2.33 million pounds, down 18 percent.

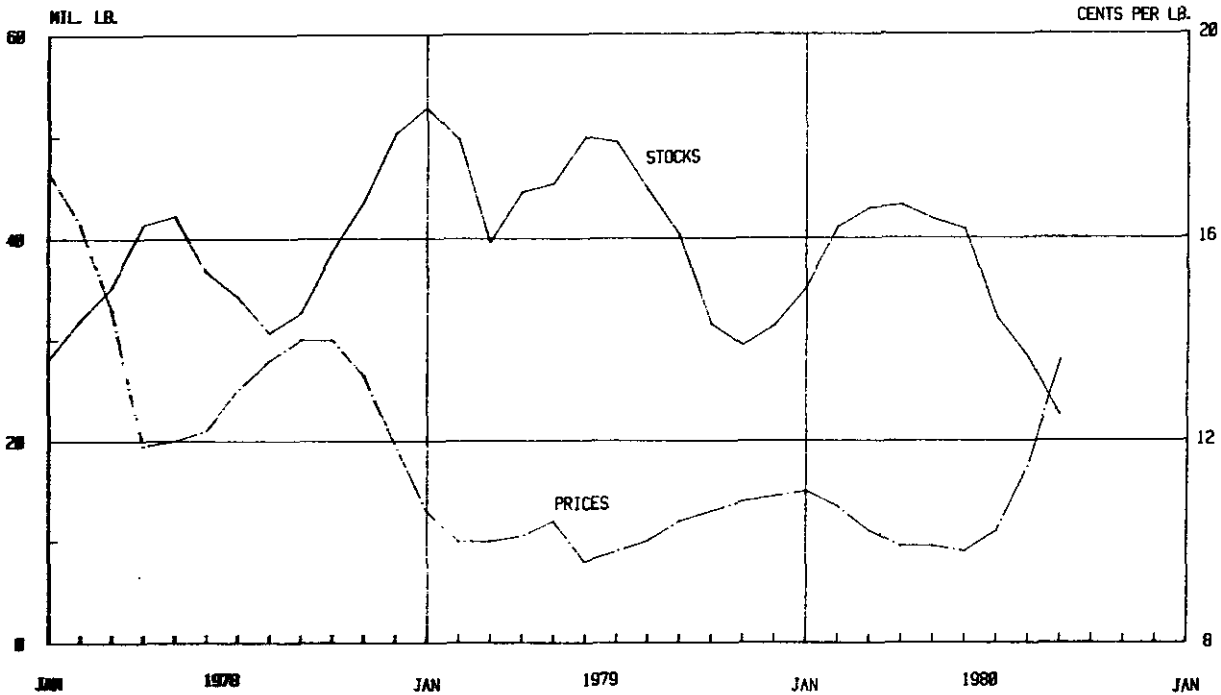
Butter and by-products, \$12.19, up 38 cents from August, and 98 cents above September 1979.

American cheese, \$12.24, an increase of 44 cents from the previous month and 79 cents above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$12.41, up 47 cents from August, and 80 cents higher than September 1979.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$11.71, 32 cents above last month, and 88 cents up from the previous year.
