NOVEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 84.9 million pounds in November, 5 percent less than October but 12 percent more than November 1979.

American type cheese totaled 177 million pounds, 5 percent below last month but 10 percent above a year earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 315 million pounds, 4 percent below the previous month but 9 percent above November 1979.

Creamed cottage cheese, 59.1 million pounds, down 7 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 13.1 million pounds, 10 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 51.5 million pounds, down 12 percent from November 1979.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with November 1979)

Ice cream -- 54.7 million gallons, down 2 percent.

Ice milk -- 16.7 million gallons, down 6 percent.

Sherbet -- 2.45 million gallons, down 10 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with November 1979)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 68.5 million pounds, up 22 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 7.90 million pounds, up 8 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.54 million pounds, up 19 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

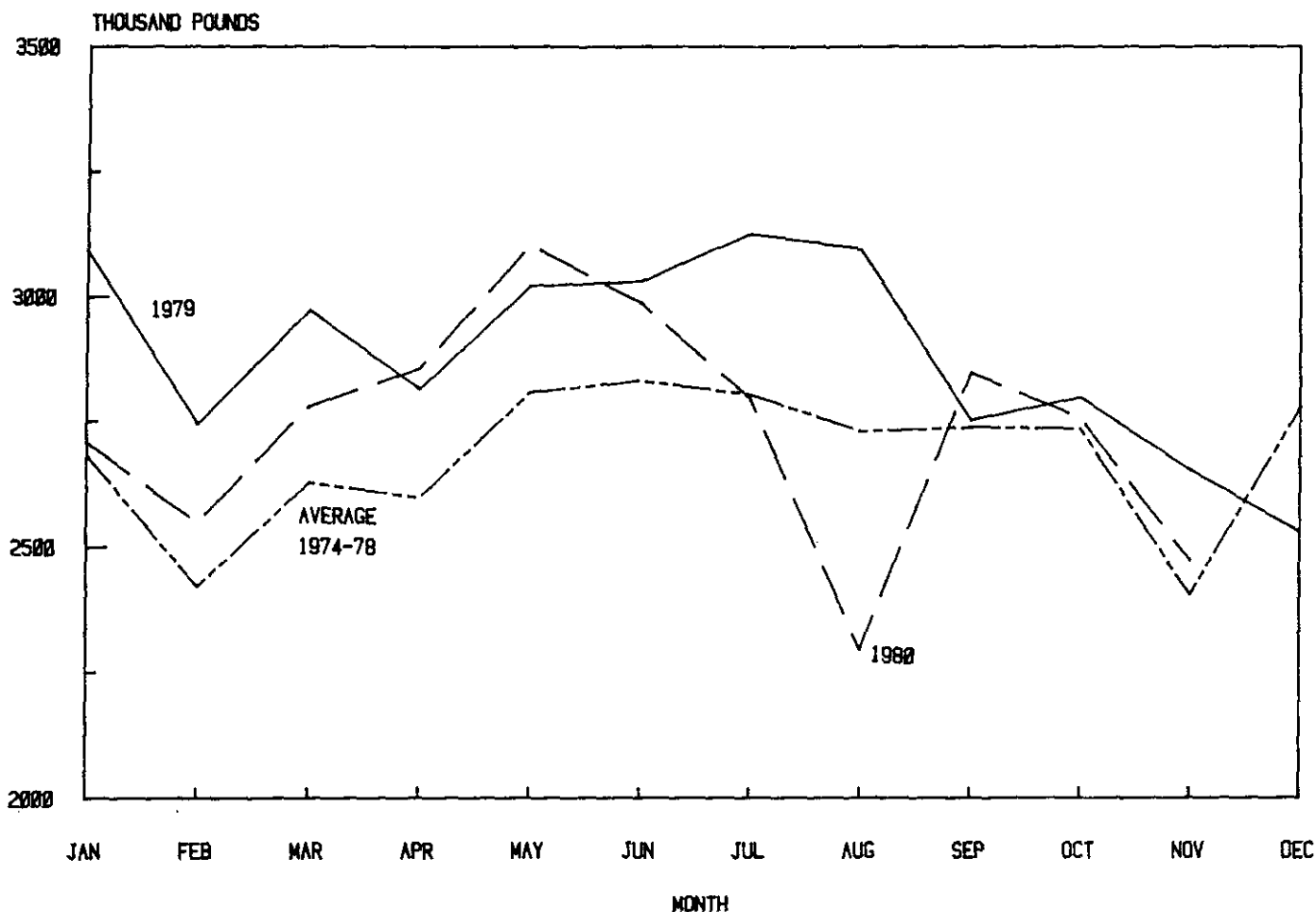
Butter and by-products, \$12.97, up 19 cents from October and \$1.37 above November 1979.

American cheese, \$12.92, an increase of 18 cents from the previous month and \$1.19 above the previous year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$13.13, up 19 cents from October, and \$1.17 higher than November 1979.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$12.38, 23 cents above last month, and \$1.05 above the previous year.
