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JANUARY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production during January was 121 million pounds (55.0 thousand metric tons), 19 percent more than December and 17 percent more than January 1980.

American type cheese production during January totaled 212 million pounds (96.2 thousand metric tons), 6 percent above the previous month and 17 percent above January last year.

Total cheese production (excluding cottage) during January amounted to 344 million pounds (156 thousand metric tons), less than 1 percent below December but 11 percent above January of last year.

Creamed cottage cheese amounted to 63.4 million pounds (28.8 thousand metric tons), 8 percent above December but 5 percent below January 1980.

Lowfat cottage cheese for December totaled 14.6 million pounds (6610 metric tons), 15 percent above the previous month and 11 percent above the same month last year.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production declined 8 percent to 55.7 million pounds (25.3 thousand metric tons) and was 7 percent below January 1980.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with January 1980)
Ice cream -- 54.1 million gallons (205 million liters), down 6 percent.
Ice milk -- 16.3 million gallons (61.6 million liters), down 2 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.71 million gallons (10.2 million liters), down 10 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with January 1980)
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 92.0 million pounds (41.7 thousand metric tons), up 23 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 6.85 million pounds (3110 metric tons), down 15 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.46 million pounds (2020 metric tons), up 3 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

Butter and by-products, \$13.03, up 3 cents from December and \$1.37 above January 1980.

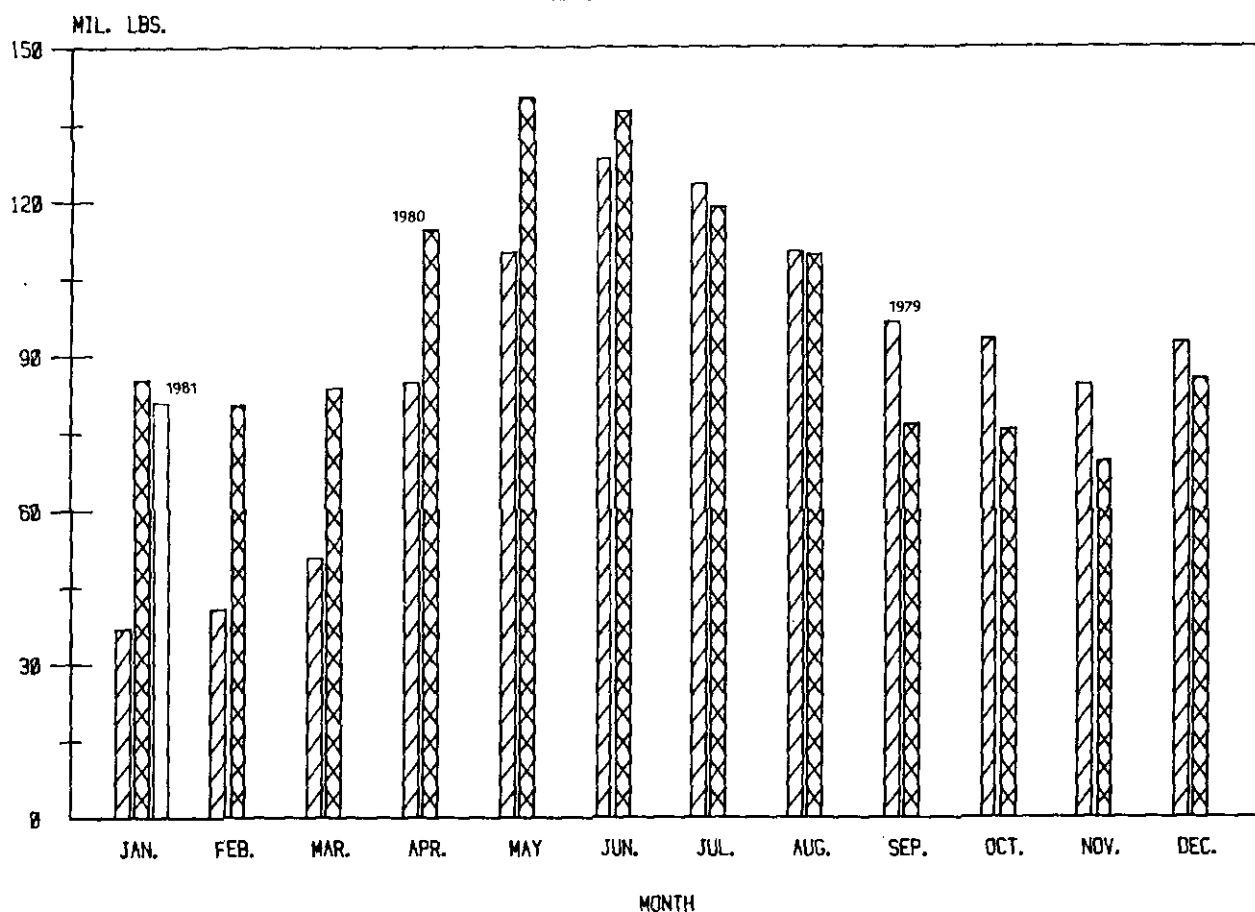
American cheese, \$12.98, a decline of 5 cents from December but \$1.21 above January last year.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$13.17, a decline of 4 cents from the previous month, but \$1.23 above January 1980.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$12.92, 18 cents above last month and \$1.49 above the previous year.
