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SEPTEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 86.3 million pounds (39.2 thousand metric tons) in September, 12 percent more than last year and 2 percent more than August 1981.

American type cheese totaled 188 million pounds (85.4 thousand metric tons), 5 percent above September 1980 but 7 percent below August 1981.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 325 million pounds (147 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent from the previous year but 2 percent below the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese, 64.6 million pounds (29.3 thousand metric tons), down 7 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese 15.8 million pounds (7170 metric tons), 4 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 60.1 million pounds (27.3 thousand metric tons), up 8 percent from September 1980.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with September 1980).

Ice cream -- 74.4 million gallons (282 million liters), up 1 percent.
Ice milk -- 25.2 million gallons (95.2 million liters), down 4 percent.
Sherbert -- 3.68 million gallons (13.9 million liters), down 3 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with September 1980).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 94.5 million pounds (42.9 thousand metric tons), up 22 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 8.42 million pounds (3820 metric tons), up 33 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 2.88 million pounds (1310 metric tons), up 19 percent.

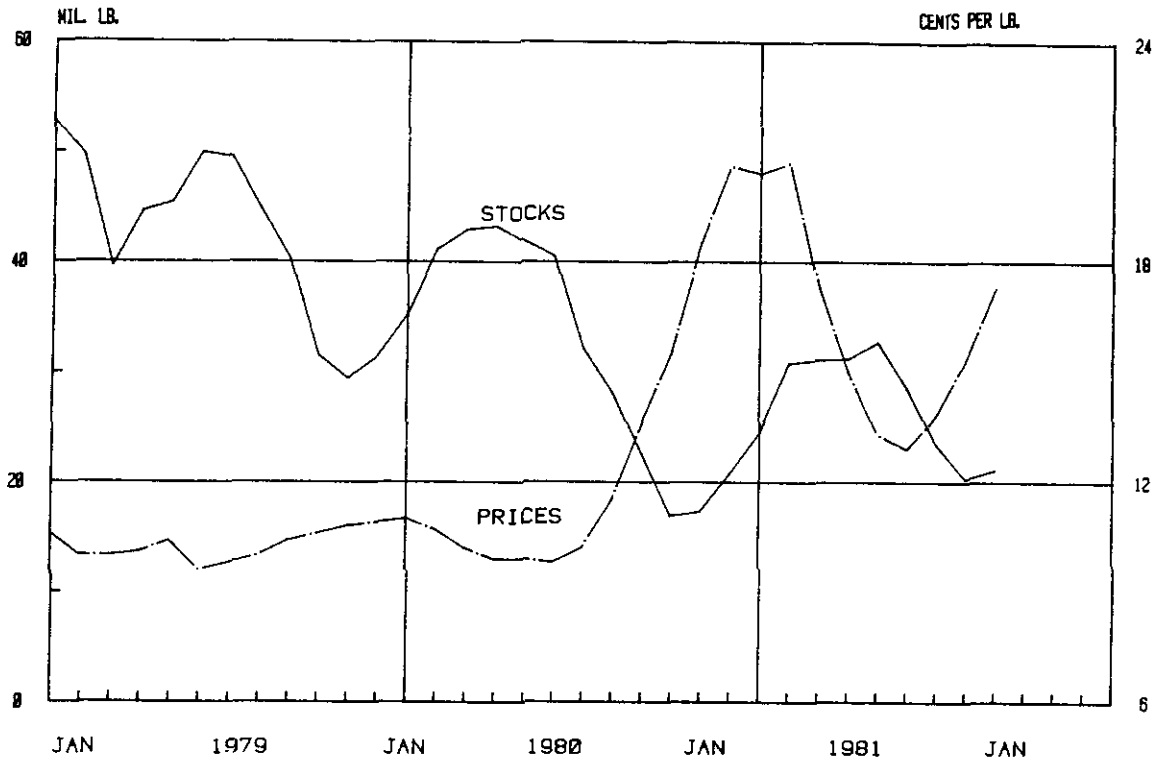
Butter and by-products, \$12.61, up 41 cents from September 1980, and 20 cents above August 1981.

American cheese, \$12.64, an increase of 37 cents from September 1980 and 21 cents above the previous month.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$12.80, up 34 cents from September 1980 and 27 cents higher than August 1981.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$12.11, 50 cents above September last year and 12 cents above the previous month.
