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DECEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 109 million pounds (49.4 thousand metric tons) in December, 5 percent more than December 1980 and 16 percent more than November 1981.

American type cheese production totaled 217 million pounds (98.4 thousand metric tons), 6 percent above December 1980 and 13 percent above a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 365 million pounds (166 thousand metric tons), up 3 percent from the previous year and 12 percent above the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese, 55.7 million pounds (25.3 thousand metric tons), down 3 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 13.2 million pounds (6010 metric tons), 5 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 68.2 million pounds (30.9 thousand metric tons), up 12 percent from December 1980.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with December 1980)

Ice cream -- 58.2 million gallons (220 million liters), up 1 percent.

Ice milk -- 16.7 million gallons (63.2 million liters), down 1 percent.

Sherbert -- 2.91 million gallons (11.0 million liters), up 2 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with December 1980).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 110 million pounds (49.7 thousand metric tons), up 22 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 8.78 million pounds (3980 metric tons), up 26 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.16 million pounds (1890 metric tons), up 4 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

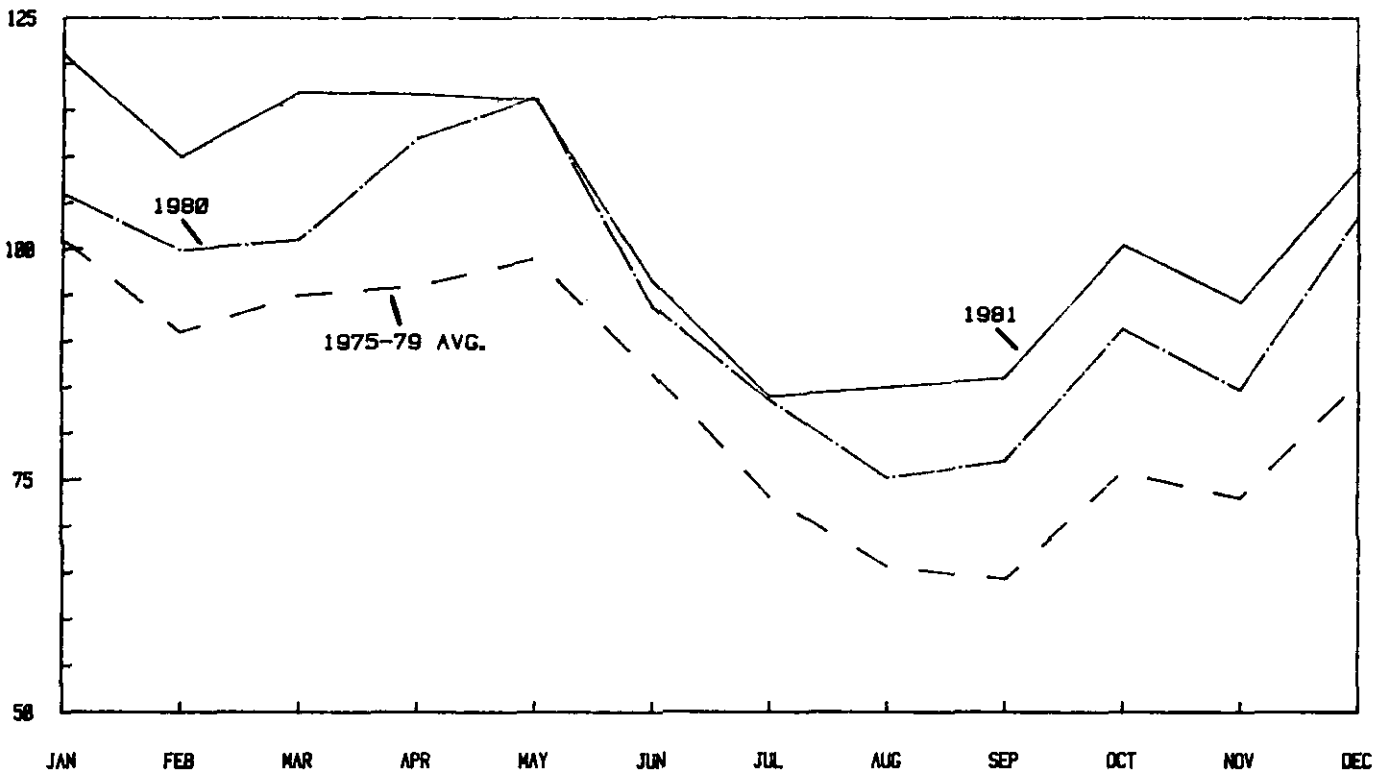
Butter and by-products, \$12.94, down 4 cents from December 1980 but 1 cent above November 1981.

American cheese, \$12.99, a decrease of 5 cents from December 1980 but unchanged from the previous month.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$13.13, down 8 cents from December 1980 and 6 cents lower than November 1981.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$12.60, 6 cents above last year and 7 cents above the previous month.
