JANUARY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 128 million pounds (58.2 thousand metric tons) in January, 6 percent more than January 1981 and 18 percent more than December 1981.

American type cheese production totaled 218 million pounds (99.1 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above January 1981 and 1 percent above a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 347 million pounds (157 thousand metric tons), up 1 percent from the previous year but was down 5 percent from the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese, 59.1 million pounds (26.8 thousand metric tons), down 7 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 14.6 million pounds (6620 metric tons), unchanged from a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 58.1 million pounds (26.4 thousand metric tons), up 4 percent from January 1981.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with January 1981)

Ice cream -- 52.1 million gallons (197 million liters), down 4 percent.
Ice milk -- 14.3 million gallons (54.1 million liters), down 12 percent.
Sherbert -- 2.72 million gallons (10.3 million liters), no change.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with January 1980).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 104 million pounds (47.2 thousand metric tons), up 13 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 9.21 million pounds (4180 metric tons), up 34 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.84 million pounds (2200 metric tons), up 9 percent.

MANUFACTURING GRADE MILK PRICES

Butter and by-products, \$12.90, down 13 cents from January 1981 and 4 cents below December 1981.

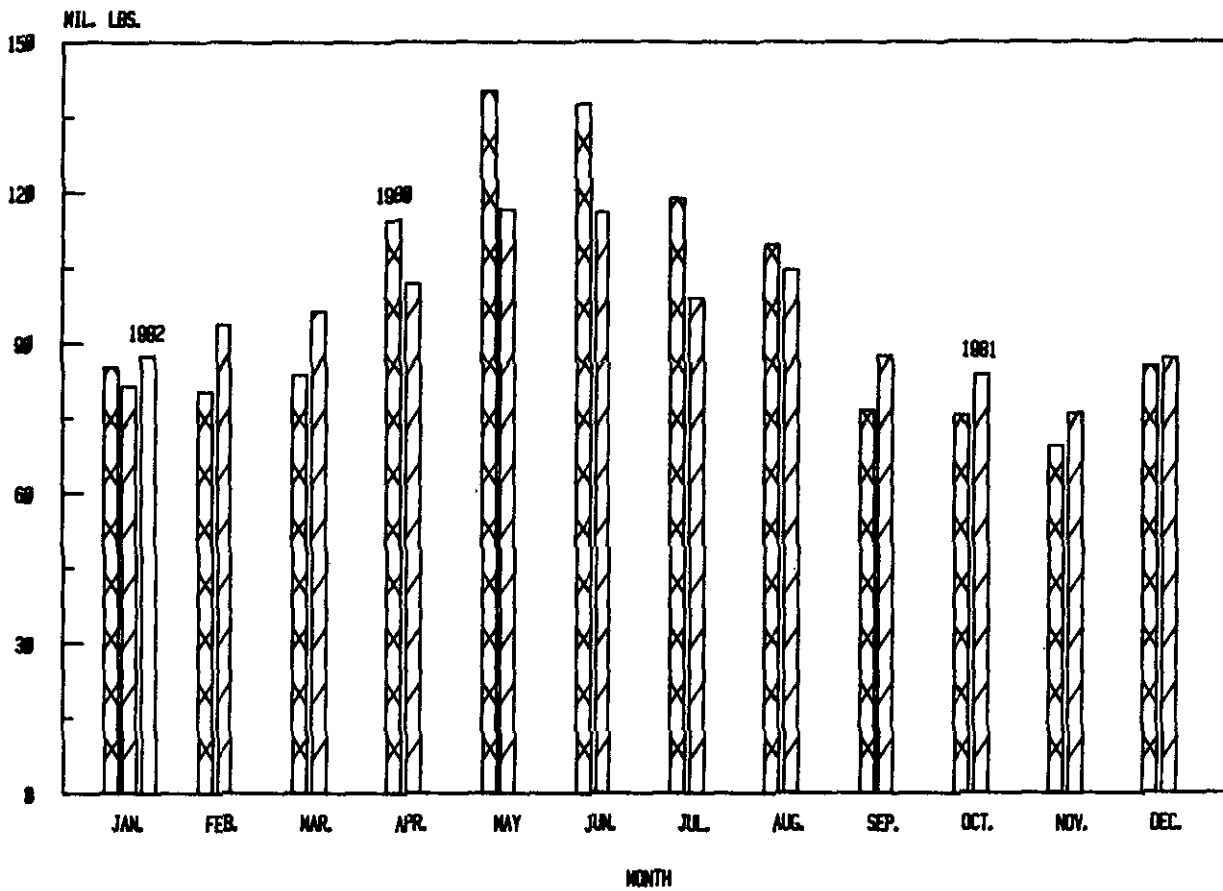
American cheese, \$12.94, a decrease of 4 cents from January 1981 and 5 cents below the previous month.

Miscellaneous cheese, \$13.13, down 4 cents from January 1981 and was unchanged from December 1981.

Evaporated milk (canned), \$12.64, 28 cents below last year but 4 cents above the previous month.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
