

DAIRY PRODUCTS

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FEBRUARY HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 117 million pounds (53.0 thousand metric tons) in February, 1982, 6 percent more than February 1981 but 9 percent less than January 1982.

American type cheese totaled 205 million pounds (93.0 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above February 1981 but 6 percent below a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 326 million pounds (148 thousand metric tons), up 3 percent from the previous year but 6 percent below the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese, 60.6 million pounds (27.5 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 16.3 million pounds (7390 metric tons), 9 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 53.6 million pounds (24.3 thousand metric tons), down 2 percent from February 1981.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with February 1981)

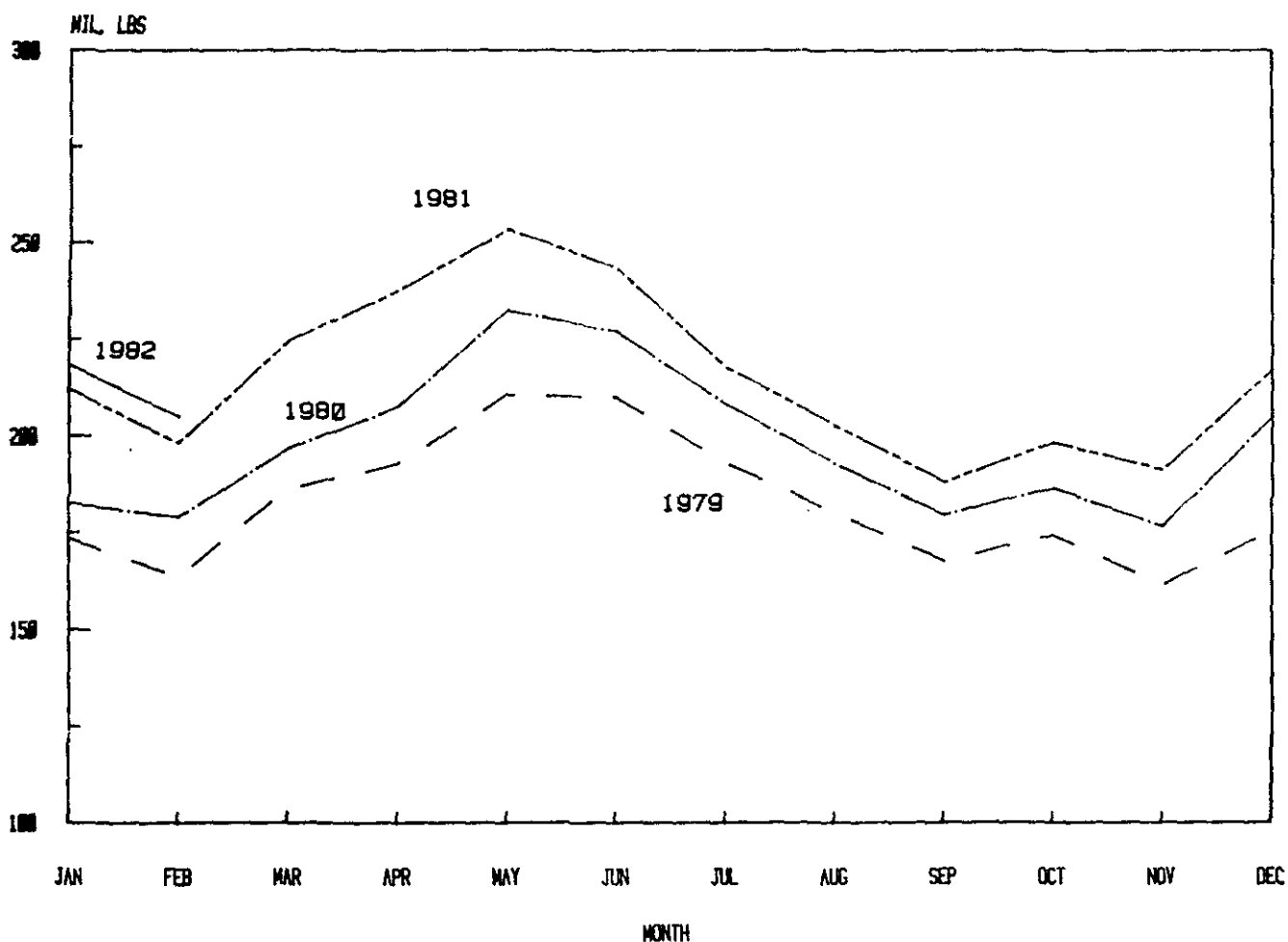
Ice cream -- 59.5 million gallons (225 million liters), down fractionally.
Ice milk -- 17.4 million gallons (65.8 million liters), down 2 percent.
Sherbert -- 2.76 million gallons (10.4 million liters), down 5 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with February 1981).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 107 million pounds (48.6 thousand metric tons), up 12 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 7.97 million pounds (3610 metric tons), up 32 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.29 million pounds (1950 metric tons), up 4 percent.

NOTE: The frequency of this report is being reduced from monthly to quarterly and several data series are being eliminated. The final monthly report will be released April 29, 1982 covering production of dairy products for March 1982. The first quarterly report will be released August 2, 1982 covering production of dairy products for the April-June quarter of 1982. The final monthly manufacturer's selling prices of whey products and canned and dry milk products and the final monthly manufacturing grade milk prices and fat tests for butter, cheese, and canned evaporated milk will be published in the report released April 29, 1982. The quarterly reports will not include price and fat test series.

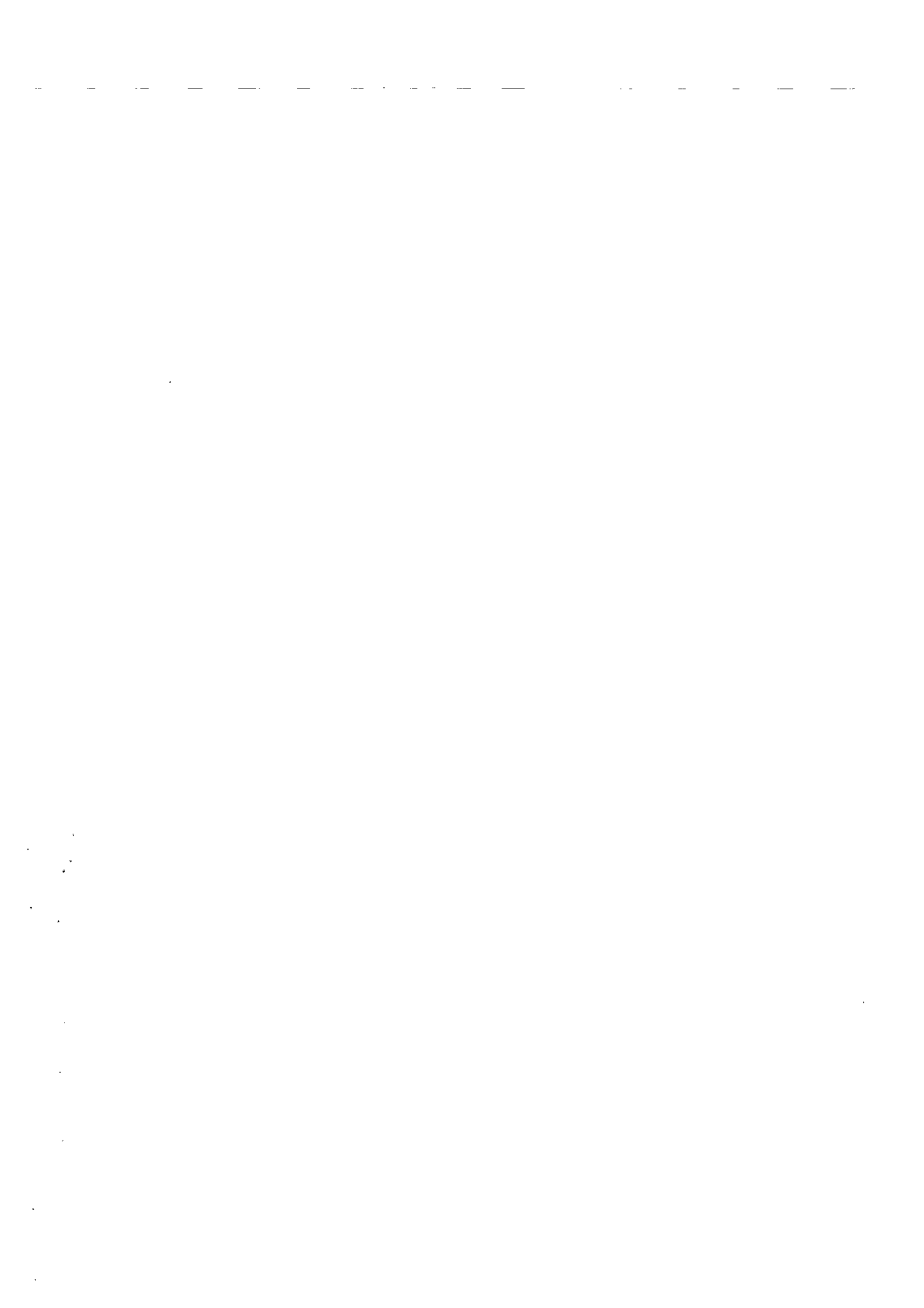
