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MARCH HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 123 million pounds (56.0 thousand metric tons) in March, 6 percent more than both March 1981 and February 1982.

American type cheese totaled 232 million pounds (105 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above March 1981 and 13 percent above a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 376 million pounds (171 thousand metric tons), up 3 percent from the previous year and 16 percent above the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese, 64.4 million pounds (29.2 thousand metric tons), down 8 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 18.7 million pounds (8460 metric tons), 5 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 61.5 million pounds (27.9 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent from March 1981.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with March 1981)

Ice cream -- 74.4 million gallons (282 million liters), up 4 percent.

Ice milk -- 24.1 million gallons (91.3 million liters), up 3 percent.

Sherbert -- 3.86 million gallons (14.6 million liters), up 9 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with March 1981).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 125 million pounds (56.8 thousand metric tons), up 14 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 9.43 million pounds (4280 metric tons), up 39 percent.

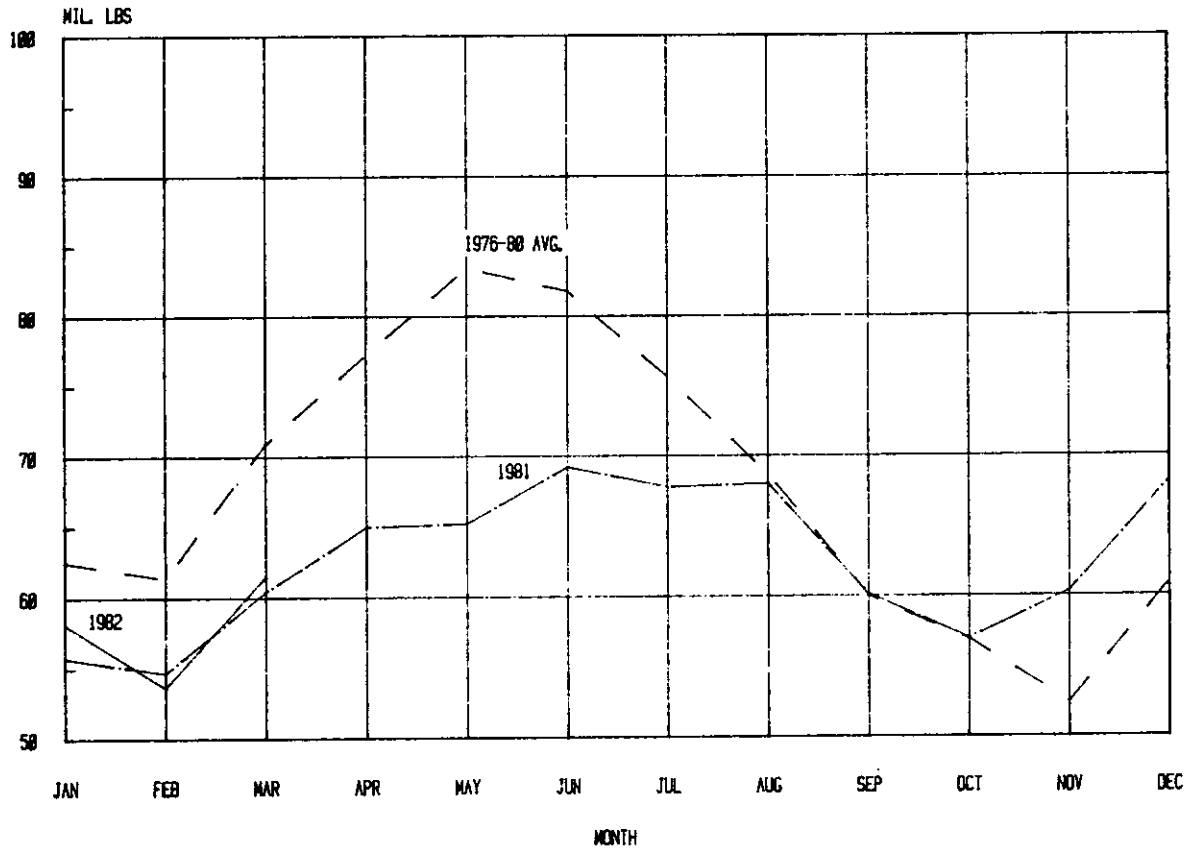
Dry buttermilk -- 4.10 million pounds (1860 metric tons), down 6 percent.

NOTE: The frequency of this report is being reduced from monthly to quarterly and several data series are being eliminated. This report is the final monthly report. The first quarterly report will be released August 2, 1982 covering production of dairy products for the April-June quarter of 1982. The quarterly reports will not include manufacturer's selling prices of whey products and canned and dry milk products or the manufacturing grade milk prices and fat tests for butter, cheese and canned evaporated milk.
