

DAIRY PRODUCTS

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OCTOBER-DECEMBER HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 295 million pounds (134 thousand metric tons) during the October-December quarter, 2 percent less than was produced during the comparable quarter in 1981.

American type cheese totaled 634 million pounds (287 thousand metric tons) during the quarter, 4 percent above the October-December quarter in 1981.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 1.10 billion pounds (501 thousand metric tons), up 6 percent from the October-December 1981 total.

Creamed cottage cheese, production at 174 million pounds (79.0 thousand metric tons), was down 1 percent from the same quarter last year.

Lowfat cottage cheese output at 47.0 million pounds (21.3 thousand metric tons), was 2 percent lower than the October-December 1981 quarter,

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 185 million pounds (83.7 thousand metric tons) was down 5 percent from the comparable quarter in 1981.

Frozen desserts: (Comparison with October-December 1981)

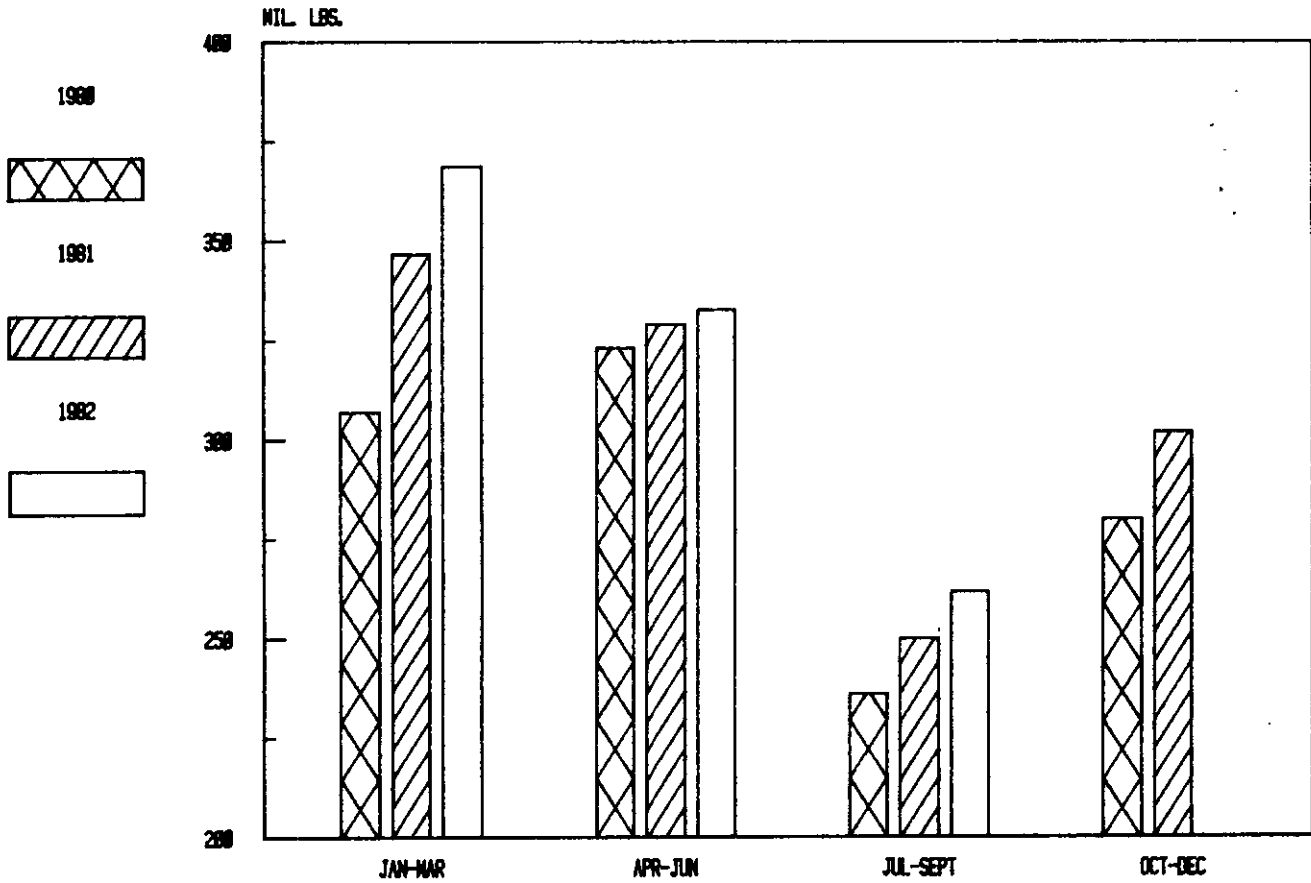
Ice Cream -- 187 million gallons (707 million liters), up 3 percent.
Ice Milk -- 57.1 million gallons (216 million liters), up 3 percent.
Sherbet -- 8.46 million gallons (32.0 million liters), up 2 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with October-December 1981)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 297 million pounds (135 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 24.5 million pounds (11.1 thousand metric tons), down 7 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 10.4 million pounds (4690 metric tons), up 1 percent.
