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JANUARY 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 134 million pounds (60.7 thousand metric tons) in January, 4 percent more than January 1982.

American type cheese totaled 233 million pounds (106 thousand metric tons), 7 percent above January 1982.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 375 million pounds (170 thousand metric tons), up 8 percent from the previous year.

Creamed cottage cheese, 61.0 million pounds (27.7 thousand metric tons), up 3 percent from a year ago.

Lowfat cottage cheese, 15.6 million pounds (7090 metric tons), 7 percent more than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk, 54.5 million pounds (24.7 thousand metric tons), down 6 percent from January 1982.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with January 1982)

Ice cream -- 55.3 million gallons (209 million liters), up 6 percent.

Ice milk -- 16.4 million gallons (62.1 million liters), up 15 percent.

Sherbert -- 2.82 million gallons (10.7 million liters), up 4 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with January 1982).

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 118 million pounds (53.4 thousand metric tons), up 13 percent.

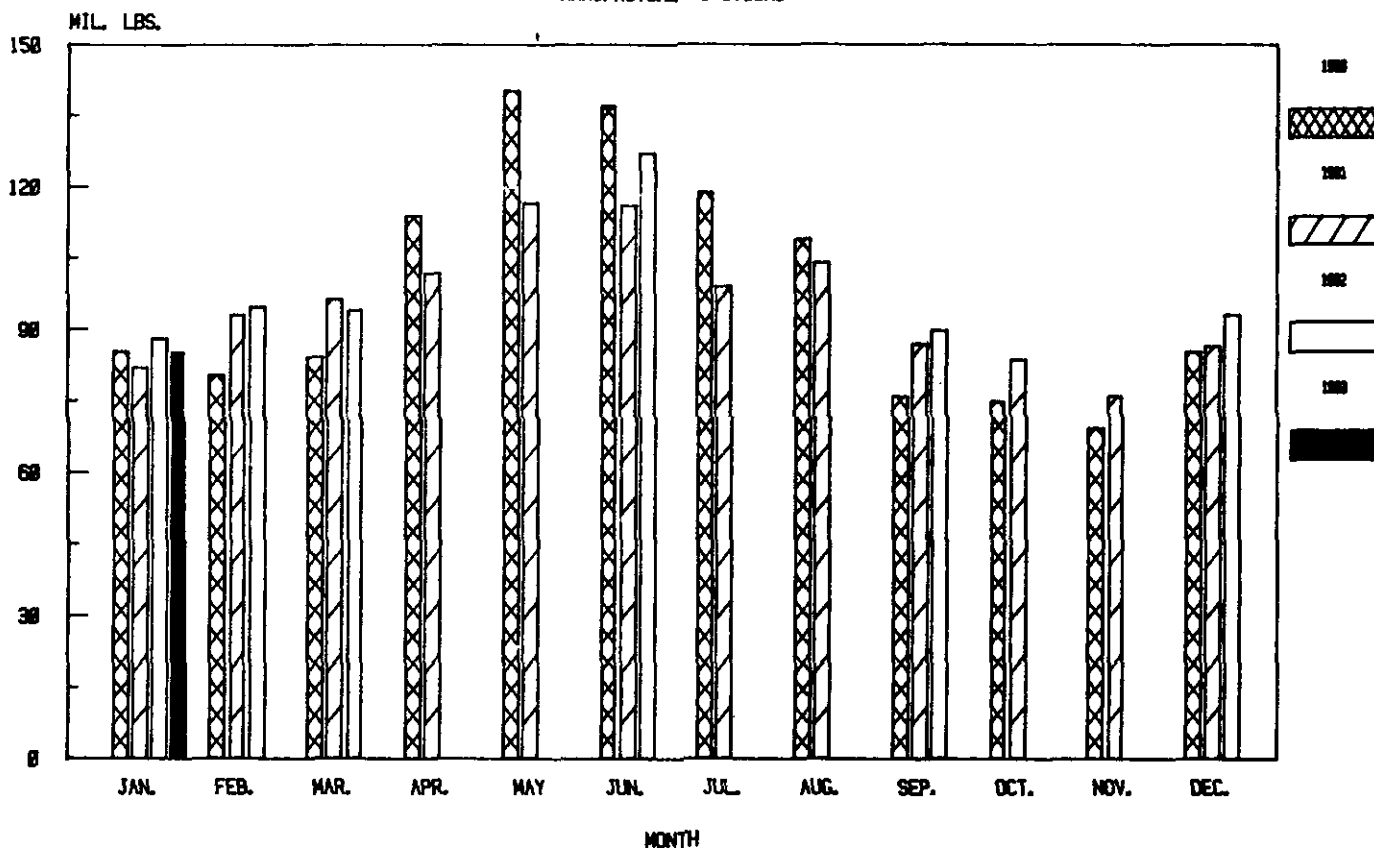
Dry whole milk -- 8.47 million pounds (3840 metric tons), down 8 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.20 million pounds (1910 metric tons), down 13 percent.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
