APRIL 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

NOTE: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter production was 126 million pounds (57.4 thousand metric tons) in April 1983, unchanged from the previous month.

American type cheese production totaled 261 million pounds (119 thousand metric tons), 2 percent more than a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during April 1983 was 408 million pounds (185 thousand metric tons), 2 percent below the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 62.5 million pounds (28.3 thousand metric tons) was down 5 percent from the previous month.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 19.5 million pounds (8830 metric tons), 3 percent less than a month earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 59.7 million pounds (27.1 thousand metric tons) was up 4 percent from March 1983.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with March 1983)

Ice cream -- 70.6 million gallons (267 million liters), down 10 percent.

Ice milk -- 25.0 million gallons (94.6 million liters), unchanged.

Sherbet -- 3.88 million gallons (14.7 million liters), up 2 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with March 1983)

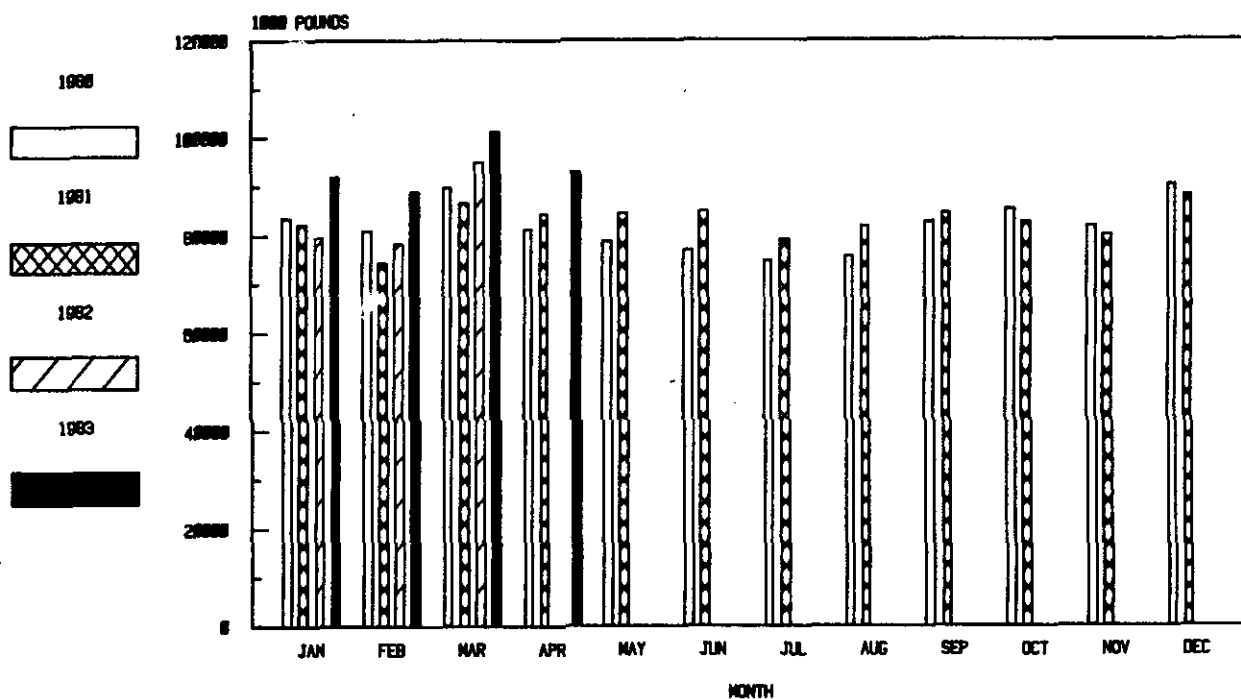
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 137 million pounds (62.3 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 9.10 million pounds (4130 metric tons), down 14 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.25 million pounds (1930 metric tons), up 11 percent.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
