MAY 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

NOTE: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter production was 121 million pounds (54.9 thousand metric tons) in May 1983, 4 percent less than the previous month.

American type cheese production totaled 278 million pounds (126 thousand metric tons), 6 percent more than a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during May 1983 was 429 million pounds (195 thousand metric tons), 5 percent above the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 65.4 million pounds (29.7 thousand metric tons) was 5 percent above the April output.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 20.5 million pounds (9320 metric tons), 5 percent above the previous month.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 61.6 million pounds (28.0 thousand metric tons) was up 3 percent from April 1983.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with April 1983)

Ice cream -- 81.0 million gallons (307 million liters), up 15 percent.

Ice milk -- 29.9 million gallons (113 million liters), up 20 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.68 million gallons (17.7 million liters), up 21 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with April 1983)

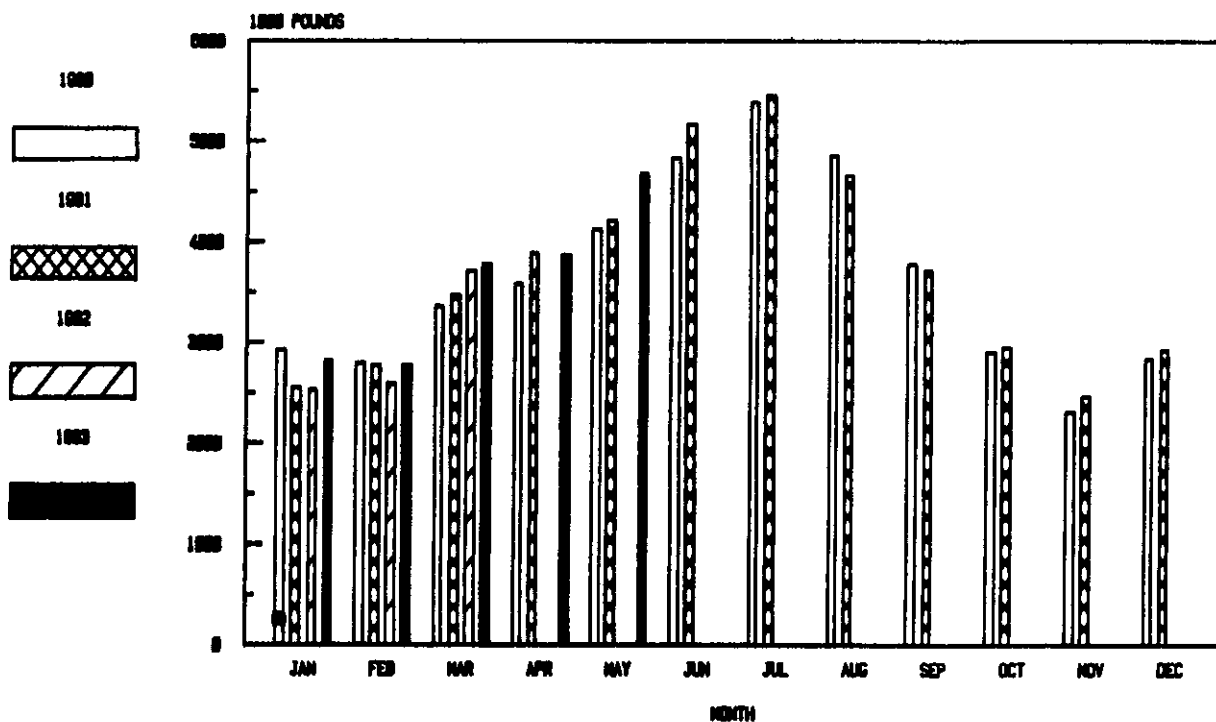
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 157 million pounds (71.1 thousand metric tons), up 14 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 8.99 million pounds (4080 metric tons), down 1 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.88 million pounds (1760 metric tons), down 9 percent.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
