JUNE 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

NOTE: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter production was 110 million pounds (49.7 thousand metric tons), 9 percent less than the previous month.

American type cheese production totaled 280 million pounds (127 thousand metric tons), 1 percent more than a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during June 1983 was 436 million pounds (198 thousand metric tons), 2 percent above the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 64.9 million pounds (29.4 thousand metric tons) was 1 percent below the May output.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 19.5 million pounds (8850 metric tons), 5 percent below the previous month.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 62.0 million pounds (28.1 thousand metric tons) was up 1 percent from May 1983.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with May 1983)

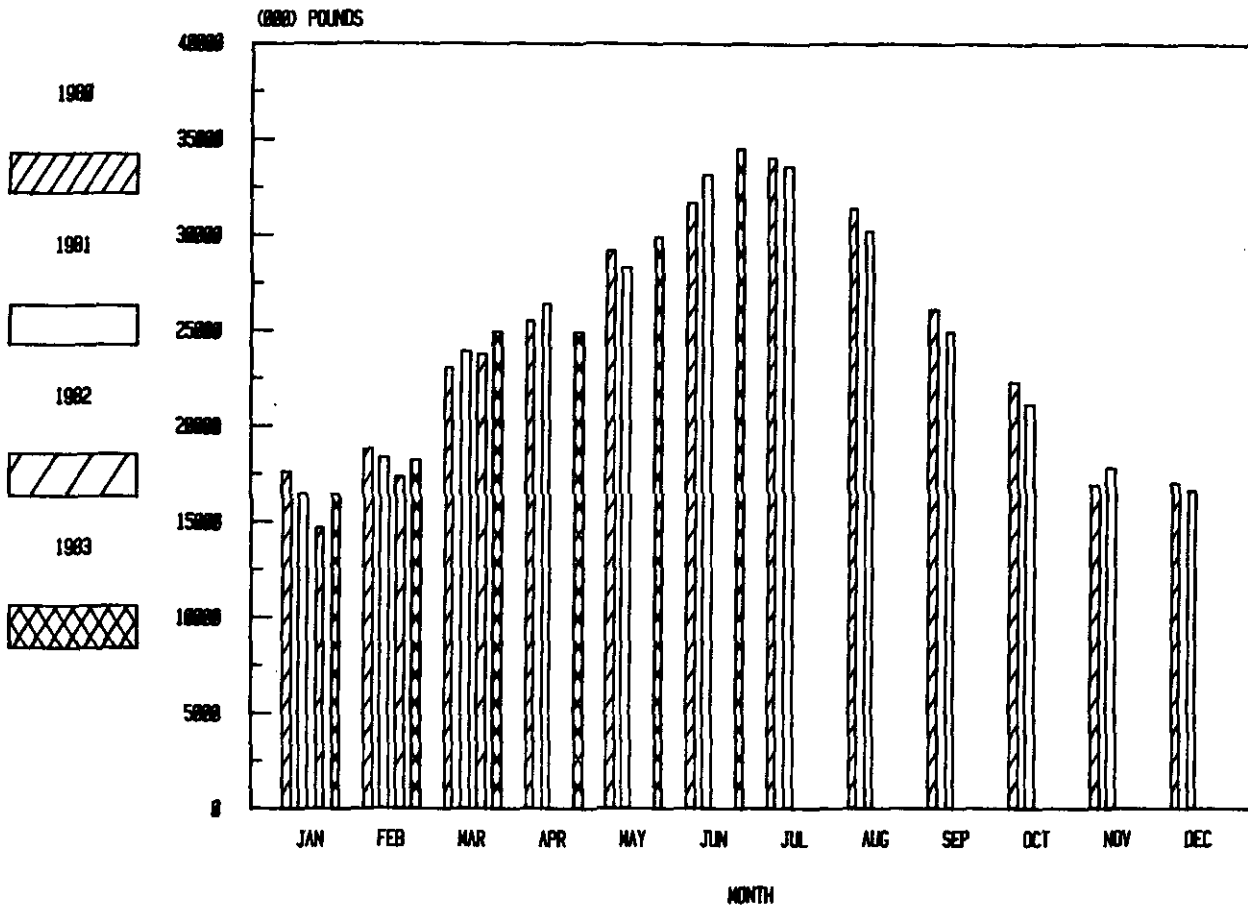
Ice cream -- 93.2 million gallons (353 million liters), up 15 percent.
Ice Milk -- 34.5 million gallons (131 million liters), up 15 percent.
Sherbet -- 5.62 million gallons (21.3 million liters), up 20 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with May 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 158 million pounds (71.6 thousand metric tons), up 1 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 8.80 million pounds (3990 metric tons), down 2 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 3.09 million pounds (1400 metric tons), down 20 percent.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
