

DAIRY PRODUCTS

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JULY 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

Note: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter Production during July 1983 was 94.7 million pounds (43.0 thousand metric tons), 14 percent less than the previous month.

American type cheese production totaled 258 million pounds (117 thousand metric tons), 8 percent less than a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during July 1983 was 401 million pounds (182 thousand metric tons), 8 percent less than the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 64.3 million pounds (29.2 thousand metric tons) was 1 percent below the previous month.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 19.1 million pounds (8650 metric tons), 2 percent below the previous month.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 54.4 million pounds (24.7 thousand metric tons) was down 12 percent from June 1983.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with June 1983)

Ice cream -- 88.4 million gallons (335 million liters), down 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 33.4 million gallons (126 million liters), down 3 percent.

Sherbet -- 5.46 million gallons (20.7 million liters), down 3 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with June 1983)

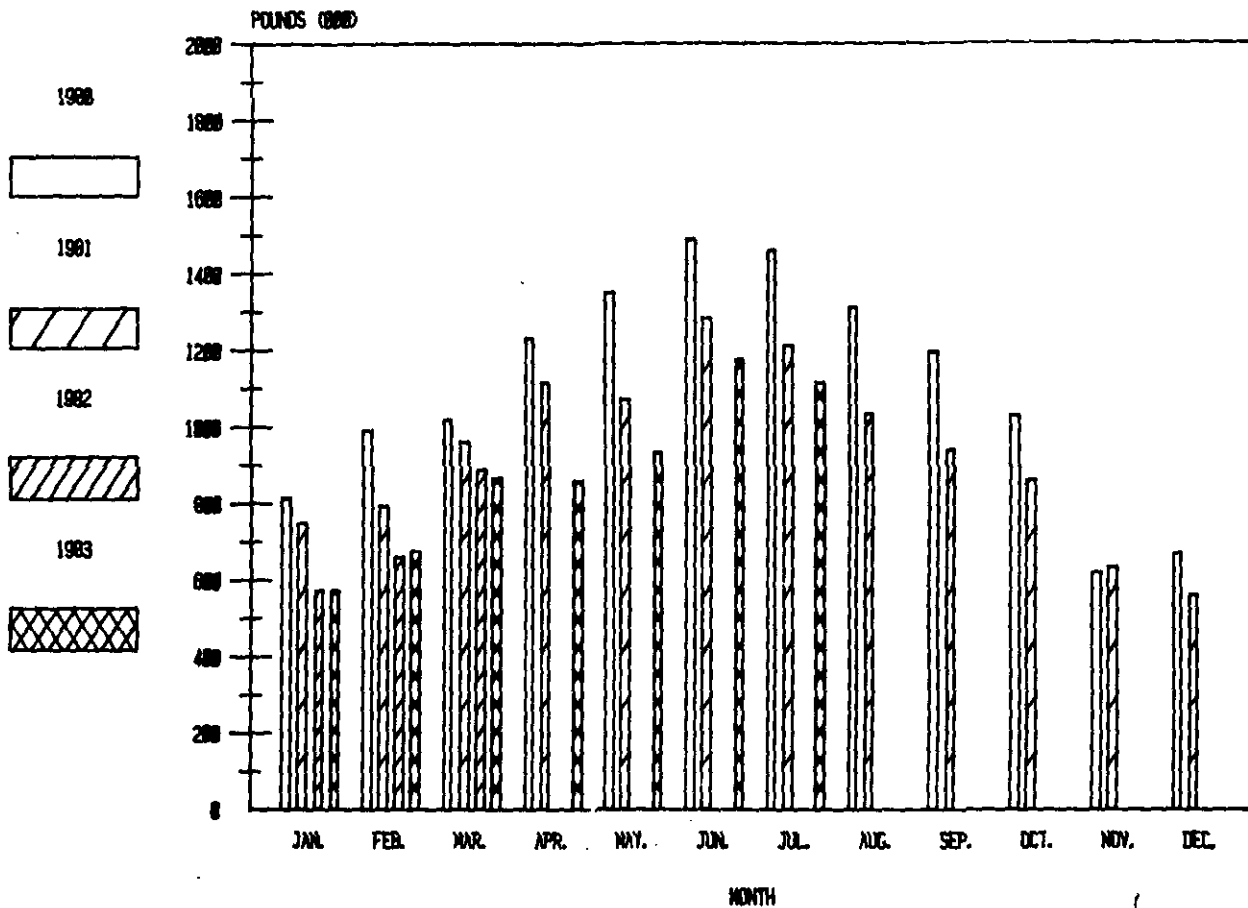
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 146 million pounds (66.1 thousand metric tons), down 8 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 7.92 million pounds (3590 metric tons), down 10 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 2.46 million pounds (1120 metric tons), down 20 percent.

ESTIMATES IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON DATA PROVIDED BY MANUFACTURERS OF DAIRY PRODUCTS TO THE STATISTICAL REPORTING SERVICE. IN ADDITION, STATE DEPARTMENTS OF AGRICULTURE IN 32 STATES ASSIST IN COLLECTING DATA. DATA ARE COLLECTED BY MAIL, PERSONAL AND TELEPHONE INTERVIEWS FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF EACH MONTH. REPORTS ARE RECEIVED FROM ALL DAIRY PLANTS IN THOSE STATES WITH SMALL NUMBERS OF PLANTS, BUT IN STATES WITH LARGE NUMBERS OF PLANTS, SURVEY PROCEDURES ARE DESIGNED TO OBTAIN REPORTS FROM ALL PLANTS IN THE LARGER SIZE STRATA AND FROM A SAMPLE OF PLANTS IN THE SMALLER SIZE STRATA. ESTIMATES ARE BASED UPON RETURNS FROM ABOUT 70 PERCENT OF PLANTS WHICH ACCOUNT FOR 75 TO 90 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL PRODUCTION OF MAJOR DAIRY PRODUCTS.
