

DAIRY PRODUCTS

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SEPTEMBER 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

Note: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter production during September 1983 was 84.2 million pounds (38.2 thousand metric tons), about the same as August 1983.

American type cheese production totaled 213 million pounds (96.7 thousand metric tons), 8 percent less than a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during September 1983 was 375 million pounds (170 thousand metric tons), 1 percent less than the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 65.0 million pounds (29.5 thousand metric tons) was 3 percent below the previous month.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 18.4 million pounds (8370 metric tons), down 4 percent from last month.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 48.9 million pounds (22.2 thousand metric tons) was down 5 percent from August 1983.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with August 1983)

Ice cream -- 80.7 million gallons (306 million liters), down 12 percent.

Ice milk -- 27.0 million gallons (102 million liters), down 19 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.25 million gallons (16.1 million liters), down 21 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with August 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 105 million pounds (47.4 thousand metric tons), down 18 percent.

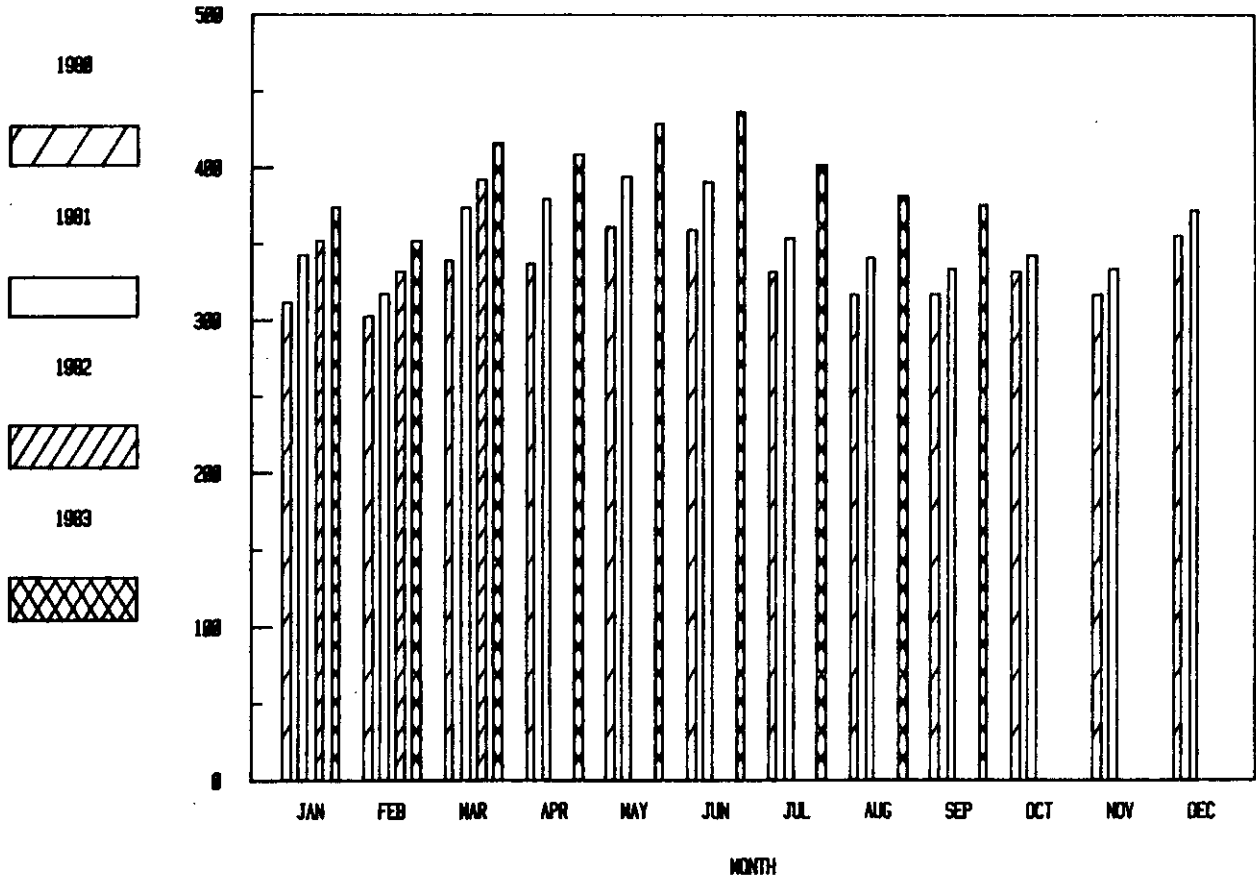
Dry whole milk -- 9.13 million pounds (4140 metric tons), up 2 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 2.26 million pounds (1030 metric tons), up 22 percent.
