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NOVEMBER 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

Note: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter production was 98.8 million pounds (44.8 thousand metric tons) in November, 1 percent above October 1983.

American type cheese production totaled 221 million pounds (100 thousand metric tons), 2 percent below a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 388 million pounds (176 thousand metric tons), 1 percent below October 1983.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 58.3 million pounds (26.4 thousand metric tons) was down 4 percent from a month earlier.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 16.1 million pounds (7280 metric tons) was down 6 percent from October.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 55.1 million pounds (25.0 thousand metric tons) was 9 percent above last month.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with October 1983)

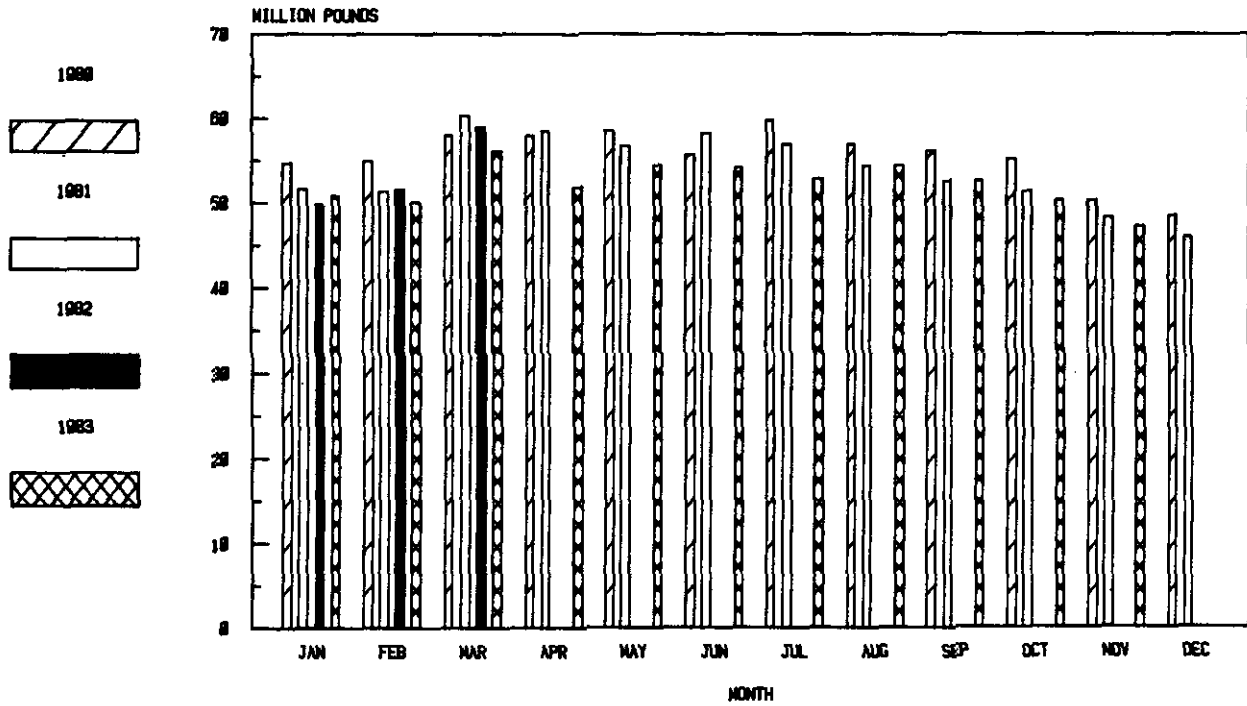
Ice cream -- 62.2 million gallons (235 million liters), down 6 percent.
Ice milk -- 18.7 million gallons (70.6 million liters), down 15 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.99 million gallons (11.3 million liters), down 3 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with October 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 99.3 million pounds (45.0 thousand metric tons), down 5 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 10.4 million pounds (4720 metric tons), up 6 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 2.76 million pounds (1250 metric tons), up 12 percent.
