DECEMBER 1983 HIGHLIGHTS

Note: Comparative monthly data for 1982 are not available for April through December.

Butter production was 108 million pounds (49.2 thousand metric tons) in December, 10 percent above November 1983.

American type cheese production totaled 242 million pounds (110 thousand metric tons), 10 percent above a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 420 million pounds (190 thousand metric tons), 8 percent above November 1983.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 52.8 million pounds (23.9 thousand metric tons) was down 9 percent from a month earlier.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 14.3 million pounds (6470 metric tons), down 11 percent from November.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 53.8 million pounds (24.4 thousand metric tons) was 2 percent below last month.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with November 1983)

Ice cream -- 58.8 million gallons (223 million liters), down 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 17.0 million gallons (64.4 million liters), down 9 percent.

Sherbet -- 2.97 million gallons (11.2 million liters), down 1 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with November 1983)

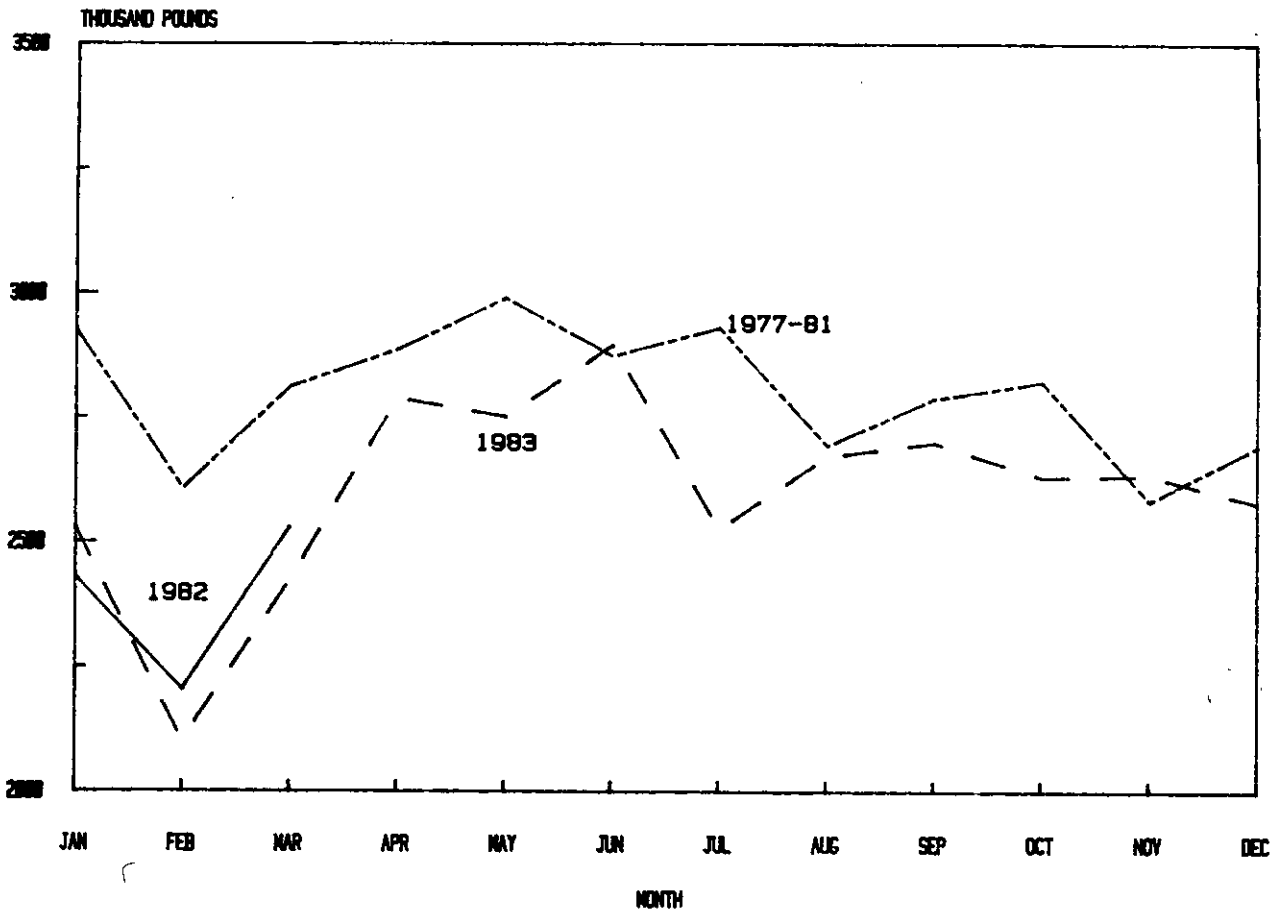
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 111 million pounds (50.2 thousand metric tons), up 11 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 9.36 million pounds (4250 metric tons), down 10 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.81 million pounds (1730 metric tons), up 38 percent.
