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FEBRUARY 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 113 million pounds (51.3 thousand metric tons) in February, 10 percent below January 1984 and 6 percent below February 1983.

American type cheese production totaled 221 million pounds (100 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below January 1984 but 2 percent above February 1983.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 369 million pounds (167 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below January 1984 but 5 percent above February 1983.

Creamed cottage cheese production, at 60.2 million pounds (27.3 thousand metric tons), was up 3 percent from both January 1984 and February 1983.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 18.2 million pounds (8270 metric tons), 6 percent above January but the same as February 1983.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production, at 44.6 million pounds (20.2 thousand metric tons), was 9 percent below January and 14 percent below February 1983.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with February 1983)

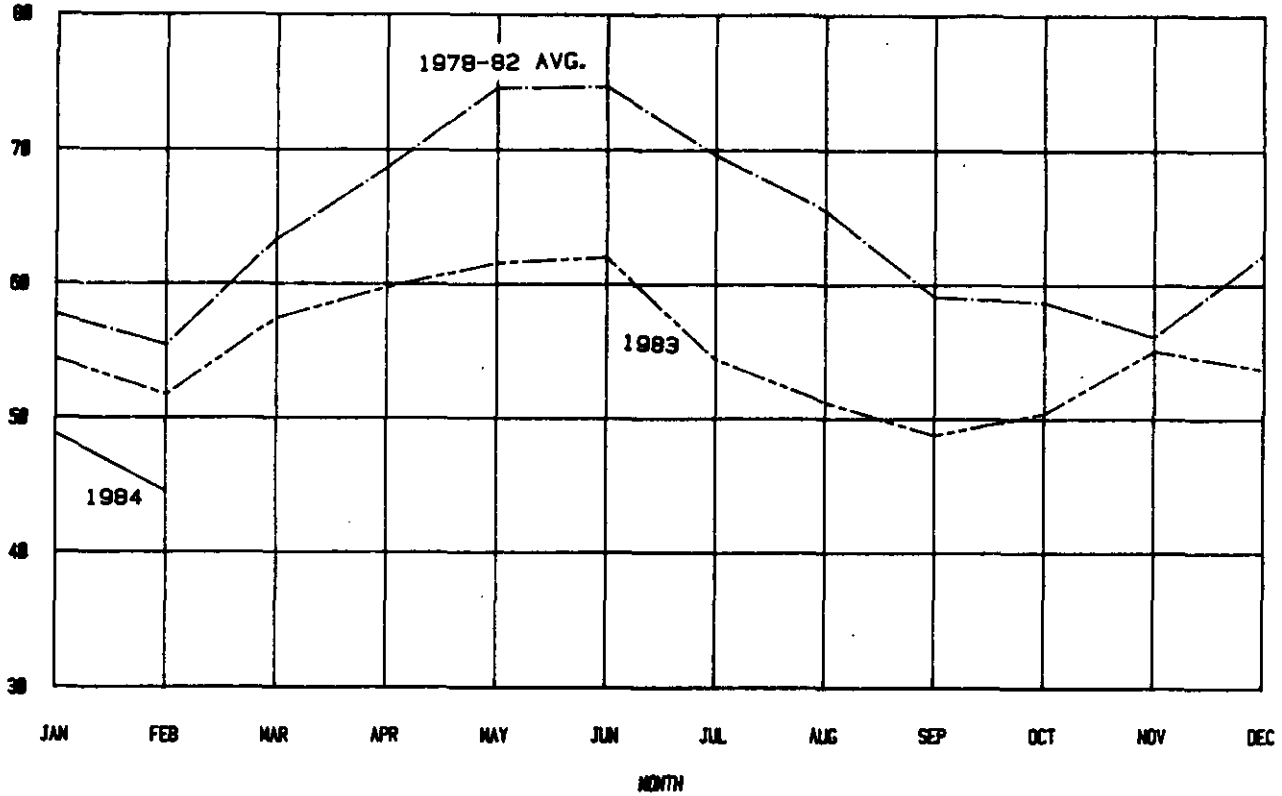
Ice cream -- 65.4 million gallons (248 million liters), up 8 percent.
Ice milk -- 21.1 million gallons (79.9 million liters), up 16 percent.
Sherbet -- 3.01 million gallons (11.4 million liters), up 9 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with February 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 105 million pounds (47.6 thousand metric tons), down 9 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 9.15 million pounds (4150 metric tons), up 20 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.02 million pounds (1820 metric tons), down 14 percent.
