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## MARCH 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 111 million pounds (50.4 thousand metric tons) in March, 12 percent below March 1983 and 2 percent below February 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 248 million pounds (112 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below March 1983 but 12 percent more than a month earlier.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during March 1984 was 413 million pounds (187 thousand metric tons), down 1 percent from the previous year but 12 percent above the previous month.

Creamed cottage cheese production at 63.8 million pounds (28.9 thousand metric tons), was down 3 percent a year earlier.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 19.9 million pounds (9010 metric tons), 1 percent less than a year earlier.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production at 51.2 million pounds (23.2 thousand metric tons) was down 11 percent from March 1983.

### Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with March 1983)

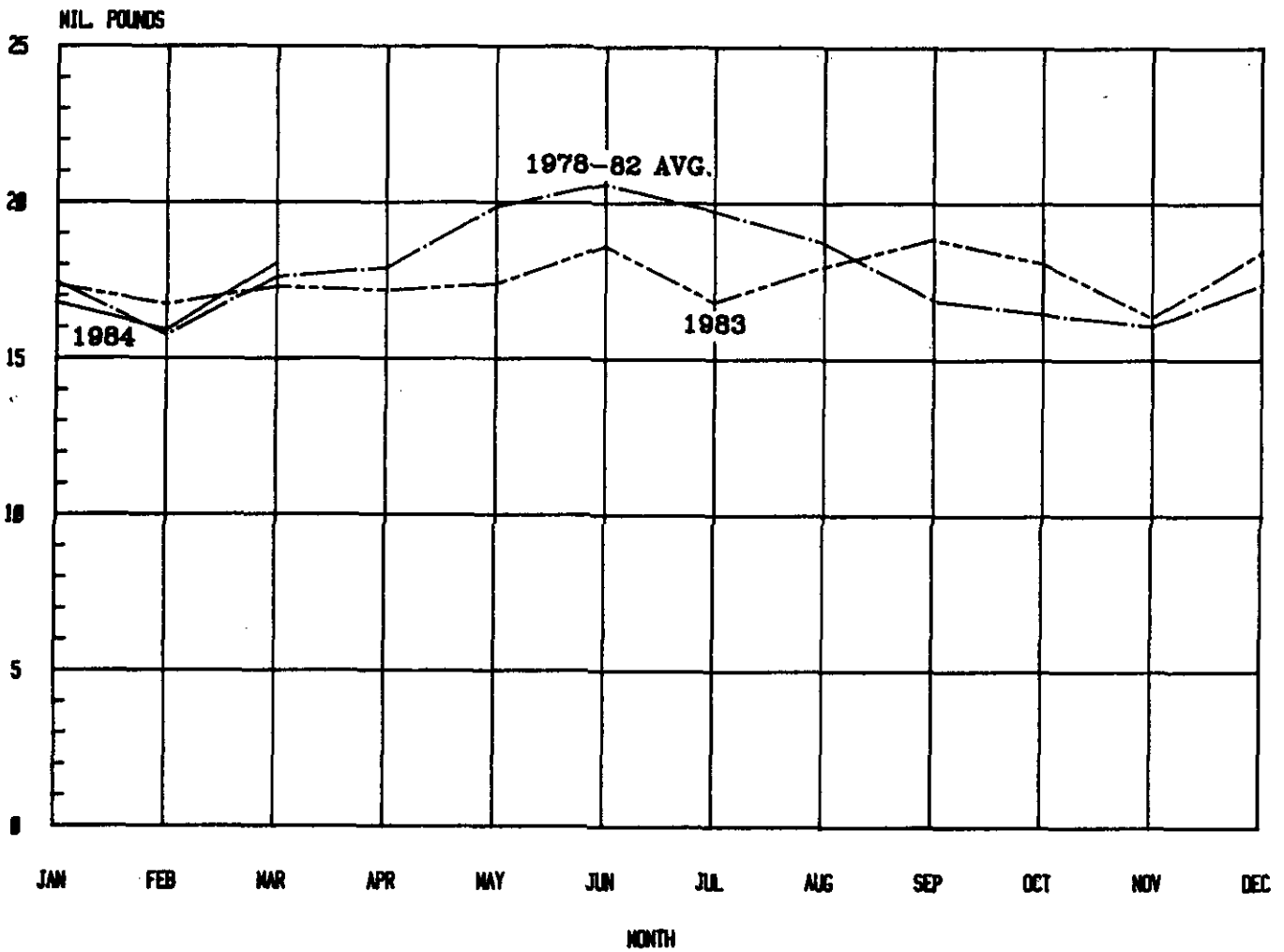
Ice cream -- 78.2 million gallons (296 million liters), down 1 percent.  
Ice milk -- 25.0 million gallons (94.5 million liters), unchanged.  
Sherbet -- 3.80 million gallons (14.4 million liters), unchanged.

### Dry milk products: (Comparisons with March 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 109 million pounds (49.5 thousand metric tons), down 19 percent.  
Dry whole milk -- 11.3 million pounds (5140 metric tons), up 8 percent.  
Dry buttermilk -- 3.79 million pounds (1720 metric tons), down 1 percent.
